Sec. 2. A public employer shall not require, by collective 2 bargaining agreement or otherwise, that a person reside within a 3 specified geographic area or within a specified distance or 4 travel time from his or her place of employment as a condition of 5 employment or promotion by the public employer. This section 6 does not apply if the person is a volunteer or paid on-call fire7 fighter, an elected official, or an unpaid appointed official.

8 Sec. 3. This act applies only to employment contracts 9 entered into, renewed, or renegotiated after the effective date 10 of this act, in accordance with the prohibition against impair11 ment of contracts provided by section 10 of article $I$ of the 12 state constitution of 1963.
