## HOUSE BILL No. 4328

February 22, 2001, Introduced by Reps. Richner, Gosselin and Kuipers and referred to the Committee on Employment Relations, Training and Safety.


1 REGULATION, RULE, OR RESOLUTION, EITHER DIRECTLY OR INDIRECTLY, A 2 MINIMUM WAGE RATE THAT IS GREATER THAN THE APPLICABLE RATE PRE3 SCRIBED IN THIS ACT. 13 (B) "LOCAL UNIT OF GOVERNMENT" MEANS A CITY, COUNTY, TOWN-

15 ANY POLITICAL SUBDIVISION OF THIS STATE.
16 (3) SUBSECTION (2) SHALL NOT LIMIT, RESTRICT, OR EXPAND A
17 PREVAILING WAGE REQUIRED UNDER 1965 PA 166, MCL 408.551 TO
