## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 1. (1) A city, village, or township that transfers any
- 2 real property to this state for a designated purpose may reenter
- 3 and repossess the property, terminating this state's estate in
- 4 the property, if this state ceases to use the real property for
- 5 the designated purpose.
- 6 (2) If this state disputes the exercise by a city, village,
- 7 or township of its right of reentry under this section and fails
- 8 promptly to deliver possession of the property, the city, vil-
- 9 lage, or township may bring an action to quiet title to, and
- 10 regain possession of, the property.
