THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 SEC. 79B. (1) SUBJECT TO SUBSECTION (2), THIS STATE SHALL
- 2 REIMBURSE ALL EXPENSES INCURRED BY A LOCAL UNIT OF GOVERNMENT TO
- 3 DEMOLISH BLIGHTED PROPERTY IN THAT LOCAL UNIT OF GOVERNMENT THAT
- 4 WAS ACQUIRED BY THAT LOCAL UNIT OF GOVERNMENT THROUGH FORFEITURE,
- 5 FORECLOSURE, AND SALE FOR DELINQUENT TAXES UNDER THE GENERAL
- 6 PROPERTY TAX ACT, 1893 PA 206, MCL 211.1 TO 211.157, MORE THAN 2
- 7 YEARS PRIOR TO THE DATE OF DEMOLITION.

- 7 (D) IS A FIRE HAZARD OR IS OTHERWISE DANGEROUS TO THE SAFETY
- 8 OF PERSONS OR PROPERTY.
- 9 (E) HAS HAD THE UTILITIES, PLUMBING, HEATING, OR SEWERAGE
- 10 PERMANENTLY DISCONNECTED, DESTROYED, REMOVED, OR RENDERED INEF-
- 11 FECTIVE SO THAT THE PROPERTY IS UNFIT FOR ITS INTENDED USE.
