## **HOUSE BILL No. 4066**

January 27, 2005, Introduced by Rep. Schuitmaker and referred to the Committee on Conservation, Forestry, and Outdoor Recreation.

A bill to amend 1994 PA 451, entitled

"Natural resources and environmental protection act,"

by amending section 74116 (MCL 324.74116), as added by 1995 PA 58.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 74116. The department shall designate the state parks in
- 2 which a park permit is required for lawful entry by motor vehicle.
- 3 The department shall designate only those parks in which state
- 4 facilities and services are provided for the public. The department
- 5 may designate portions of state parks where a park permit is not
- 6 necessary. The department shall post signs at designated parks or
  - designated portions of parks that state that a motor vehicle park
  - permit is required. A person shall not enter any state park or
- 9 portion of a state park in which a motor vehicle park permit is
  - required without a valid motor vehicle permit affixed to the

- 1 vehicle. A valid park permit procured pursuant to section 74117
- 2 shall be permanently affixed to -the lower right-hand corner of the
- 3 windshield of any EACH motor vehicle entering a state park or
- 4 portion of a state park in which a motor vehicle park permit is
- 5 required. -, except that THE PARK PERMIT SHALL BE AFFIXED TO THE
- 6 MOTOR VEHICLE'S WINDSHIELD IN THE AREA DESIGNATED BY THE
- 7 DEPARTMENT. HOWEVER, a park permit is not required to be affixed to
- 8 a motor vehicle while the motor vehicle is being driven or parked
- 9 within an established federal, state, or county highway within a
- 10 state park. The requirement to obtain a motor vehicle park permit
- 11 does not apply to -motor vehicles ANY OF THE FOLLOWING:
- 12 (A) A RECREATIONAL VEHICLE FUNCTIONING AS A STATIONARY PRIMARY
- 13 CAMPING SHELTER CAMPED LEGALLY IN AND NOT MOVED FROM THE STATE PARK
- 14 CAMPGROUND DURING THE PERIOD OF THE CAMPING STAY. THE EXEMPTION
- 15 PROVIDED FOR IN THIS SUBDIVISION APPLIES ONLY IF BOTH OF THE
- 16 FOLLOWING CONDITIONS ARE MET:
- 17 (i) THE OPERATION OF THE RECREATIONAL VEHICLE IS LIMITED TO THE
- 18 DATE OF ARRIVAL AND THE DATE OF DEPARTURE.
- 19 (ii) THE RECREATIONAL VEHICLE IS PART OF A CAMP THAT INCLUDES 1
- 20 ADDITIONAL MOTORIZED VEHICLE.
- 21 (B) A MOTOR VEHICLE used in the operation or maintenance of A
- 22 state <del>parks, to PARK.</del>
- 23 (C) AN emergency -vehicles, or to VEHICLE.
- 24 (D) A state-owned or law enforcement motor <u>vehicles</u> VEHICLE
- 25 or private motor -vehicles VEHICLE being operated on official
- 26 state business.
