## SUBSTITUTE FOR HOUSE BILL NO. 4588

A bill to amend 1984 PA 431, entitled "The management and budget act,"

by amending section 263 (MCL 18.1263), as amended by 2004 PA 589.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 263. (1) The director may authorize a state agency to
- 2 purchase supplies and materials for the purpose of maintaining
- 3 inventories. The director shall place a dollar or quantity
- 4 limitation to insure inventories are maintained at acceptable
- 5 levels. Appropriation accounts shall be charged upon the basis of
- 6 actual usage. Any state agency so authorized shall conduct periodic
- 7 inventories as directed by the director of all supplies and
- 8 materials under their control. Obsolete, damaged, or spoiled
- 9 supplies and materials shall be charged to the proper appropriation
- 10 account during the fiscal year it is determined that obsolescence,

- 1 damage, or spoilage has occurred.
- 2 (2) The department shall provide assistance to any city,
- 3 village, county, township, school district, intermediate school
- 4 district, nonprofit hospital, institution of higher education, or
- 5 community or junior college for purchasing services on a fee basis.
- 6 Fees collected for the provision of that assistance are
- 7 appropriated for the additional expenses incurred.
- 8 (3) The department shall create and operate a cooperative bulk
- 9 purchasing program CALLED THE MIDEAL PLAN for LOCAL UNITS OF
- 10 GOVERNMENT, school districts, public school academies, nonpublic
- 11 schools, and intermediate school districts on a fee basis to reduce
- 12 the costs of purchasing goods and services. Fees collected under
- 13 this subsection shall not exceed the cost of purchasing goods and
- 14 services and reasonable administrative expenses, and are
- 15 appropriated for the expenses incurred. THE DEPARTMENT SHALL
- 16 SOLICIT FEEDBACK FROM PARTICIPANTS IN THE MIDEAL PLAN REGARDING HOW
- 17 THE PLAN COULD BE IMPROVED AND SHALL CONSIDER THAT FEEDBACK WHEN
- 18 MAKING CHANGES TO THE MIDEAL PLAN. THE DEPARTMENT SHALL CREATE AND
- 19 MAINTAIN A WEBSITE THAT CONTAINS INFORMATION ON THE MIDEAL PLAN AND
- 20 DESCRIBES THE PRODUCTS AND SERVICES THAT ARE AVAILABLE THROUGH THE
- 21 MIDEAL PLAN. BEGINNING JANUARY 1, 2008, THE DEPARTMENT SHALL WAIVE
- 22 50% OF THE MEMBERSHIP FEE FOR THE MIDEAL PLAN TO A LOCAL UNIT OF
- 23 GOVERNMENT, A SCHOOL DISTRICT, OR AN INTERMEDIATE SCHOOL DISTRICT
- 24 THAT DOES BOTH OF THE FOLLOWING:
- 25 (A) SUBMITS TO THE DEPARTMENT A COPY OF A RESOLUTION BY THE
- 26 LEGISLATIVE BODY OF THE LOCAL UNIT OF GOVERNMENT, SCHOOL DISTRICT,
- 27 OR INTERMEDIATE SCHOOL DISTRICT THAT COMMITS THAT LOCAL UNIT OF

- GOVERNMENT, SCHOOL DISTRICT, OR INTERMEDIATE SCHOOL DISTRICT TO 1
- 2 USING THE MIDEAL PLAN FOR ALL PURCHASING UNLESS 1 OR MORE OF THE
- 3 FOLLOWING APPLY:
- 4 (i) THE LOCAL UNIT OF GOVERNMENT, SCHOOL DISTRICT, OR
- 5 INTERMEDIATE SCHOOL DISTRICT CAN GET THE GOODS OR SERVICES AT A
- PRICE OF LESS THAN 105% OF THE MIDEAL PLAN PRICE. 6
- (ii) THE LOCAL UNIT OF GOVERNMENT, SCHOOL DISTRICT, OR 7
- INTERMEDIATE SCHOOL DISTRICT PURCHASES THE GOODS OR SERVICES FROM A 8
- 9 SUPPLIER LOCATED WITHIN THE BOUNDARY OR WITHIN 5 MILES OUTSIDE OF
- 10 THE BOUNDARY OF THE LOCAL UNIT OF GOVERNMENT, SCHOOL DISTRICT, OR
- 11 INTERMEDIATE SCHOOL DISTRICT.
- 12 (iii) THE LOCAL UNIT OF GOVERNMENT, SCHOOL DISTRICT, OR
- INTERMEDIATE SCHOOL DISTRICT DECLARES AN EMERGENCY AND PURCHASES 13
- 14 THE GOODS OR SERVICES FOR THE IMMINENT PROTECTION OF PUBLIC HEALTH
- 15 OR SAFETY.
- (iv) THE MIDEAL PLAN DOES NOT OFFER THE GOOD OR SERVICE. 16
- 17 (B) AGREES TO SUBMIT TO THE DEPARTMENT EACH YEAR A REPORT
- 18 DETAILING WHICH MIDEAL PURCHASES WERE CONSIDERED AND WHICH MIDEAL
- 19 PURCHASES WERE MADE.
- 20 (4) AS USED IN SUBSECTION (3), "LOCAL UNIT OF GOVERNMENT"
- MEANS A COUNTY, CITY, VILLAGE, OR TOWNSHIP LOCATED IN THIS STATE. 21
