

HOUSE BILL No. 4775

May 16, 2007, Introduced by Reps. Wenke, LeBlanc, Shaffer and Rocca and referred to the Committee on Government Operations.

A bill to allow public officials to elect not to receive compensation for serving in their elected or appointed positions.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Sec. 1. (1) Upon written notice to the legislative body of the
2 county, city, township, or village in which a person serves as a
3 public official, the person may elect not to receive compensation
4 for serving as a public official.

5 (2) As used in this act:

6 (a) "Legislative body" means any of the following:

7 (i) The county board of commissioners of a county.

8 (ii) The council, commission, or other entity vested with the
9 legislative power of a city.

10 (iii) The township board of a township.

1 (iv) The council, commission, or other entity vested with the
2 legislative power of a village.

3 (b) "Public official" means a person who is elected or
4 appointed to any of the following:

5 (i) A public office of a county, city, township, or village in
6 this state.

7 (ii) A department, board, agency, institution, commission,
8 authority, division, council, or other public entity of a county,
9 city, township, or village in this state.
