## HOUSE BILL No. 4995

June 28, 2007, Introduced by Rep. Virgil Smith and referred to the Committee on Insurance.

A bill to amend 1956 PA 218, entitled

"The insurance code of 1956,"

(MCL 500.100 to 500.8302) by adding section 3136.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 SEC. 3136. IF AN INJURED PERSON RECOVERS DAMAGES UNDER SECTION 2 3135 FOR NONECONOMIC LOSS OR EXCESS ECONOMIC LOSS AND IS REQUIRED 3 TO PAY ALL OR A PORTION OF THAT RECOVERY TO ANY PERSON OR ENTITY 4 CLAIMING A LIEN OR RIGHT OF REIMBURSEMENT, SUBROGATION, RECOUPMENT, OR OFFSET AGAINST THE RECOVERY, THE INSURER RESPONSIBLE TO PAY 5 6 PERSONAL PROTECTION INSURANCE BENEFITS TO THE INJURED PERSON SHALL 7 REIMBURSE THE INJURED PERSON FOR THE AMOUNT HE OR SHE IS REQUIRED TO PAY THE PERSON OR ENTITY TO THE EXTENT THAT THE PAYMENT WOULD 8 9 HAVE BEEN PAYABLE BY THE INSURER IF THE PERSON OR ENTITY HAD NOT 10 PAID THOSE AMOUNTS. THIS SECTION APPLIES TO ANY CASE FILED ON OR
