THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 SEC. 2977. IF AN ELECTED OFFICIAL OF A MUNICIPALITY HAS BEEN
- 2 CONVICTED OF A CRIMINAL ACT AND IF THE CRIMINAL ACT HAS CAUSED THE
- 3 MUNICIPALITY TO SUSTAIN A PECUNIARY LOSS BECAUSE OF A CIVIL
- 4 JUDGMENT OR SETTLEMENT OF A CIVIL ACTION, THE MUNICIPALITY MAY
- 5 BRING A CIVIL ACTION AGAINST THE ELECTED OFFICIAL TO RECOVER THE
- 6 LOSS SUSTAINED BY THE MUNICIPALITY.
