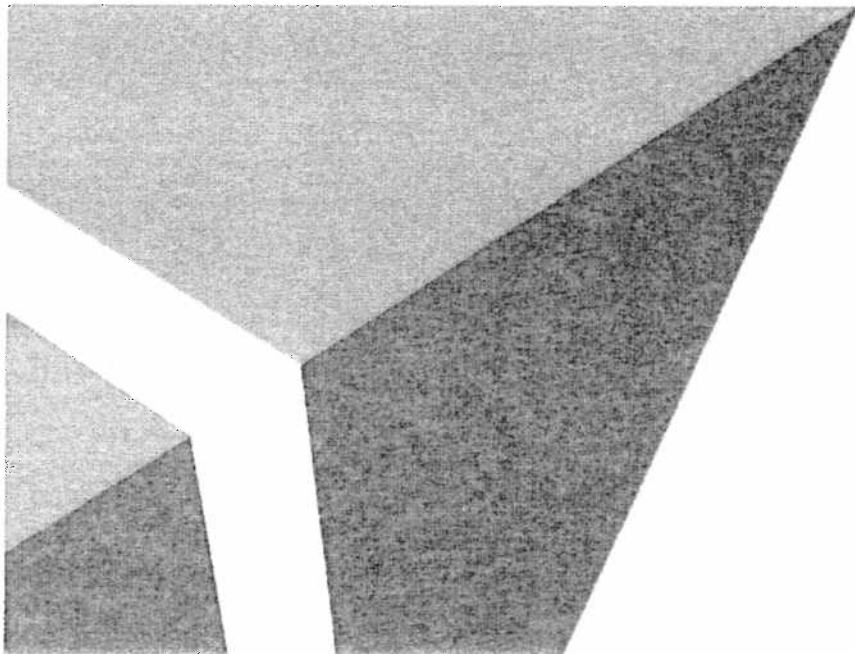

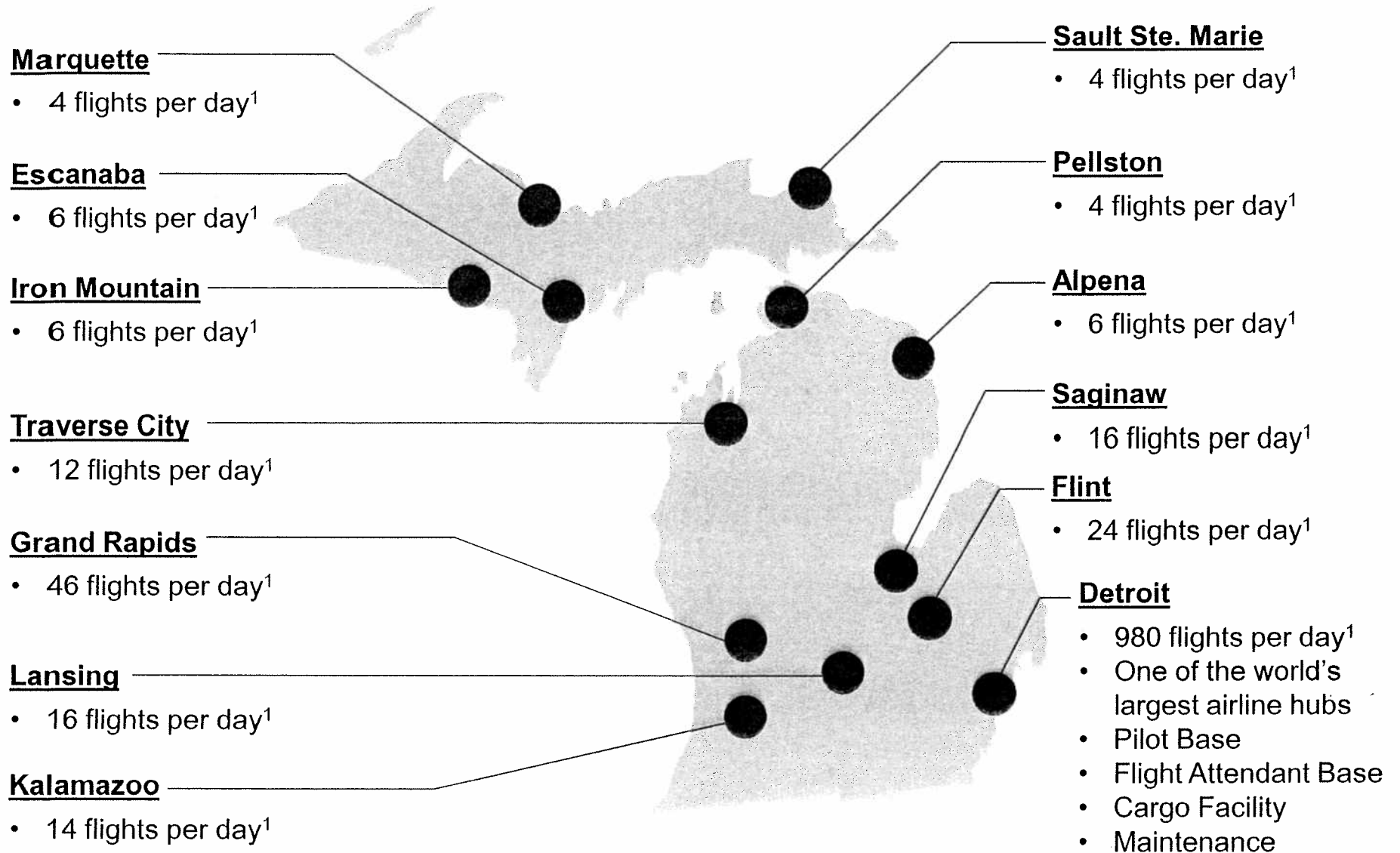

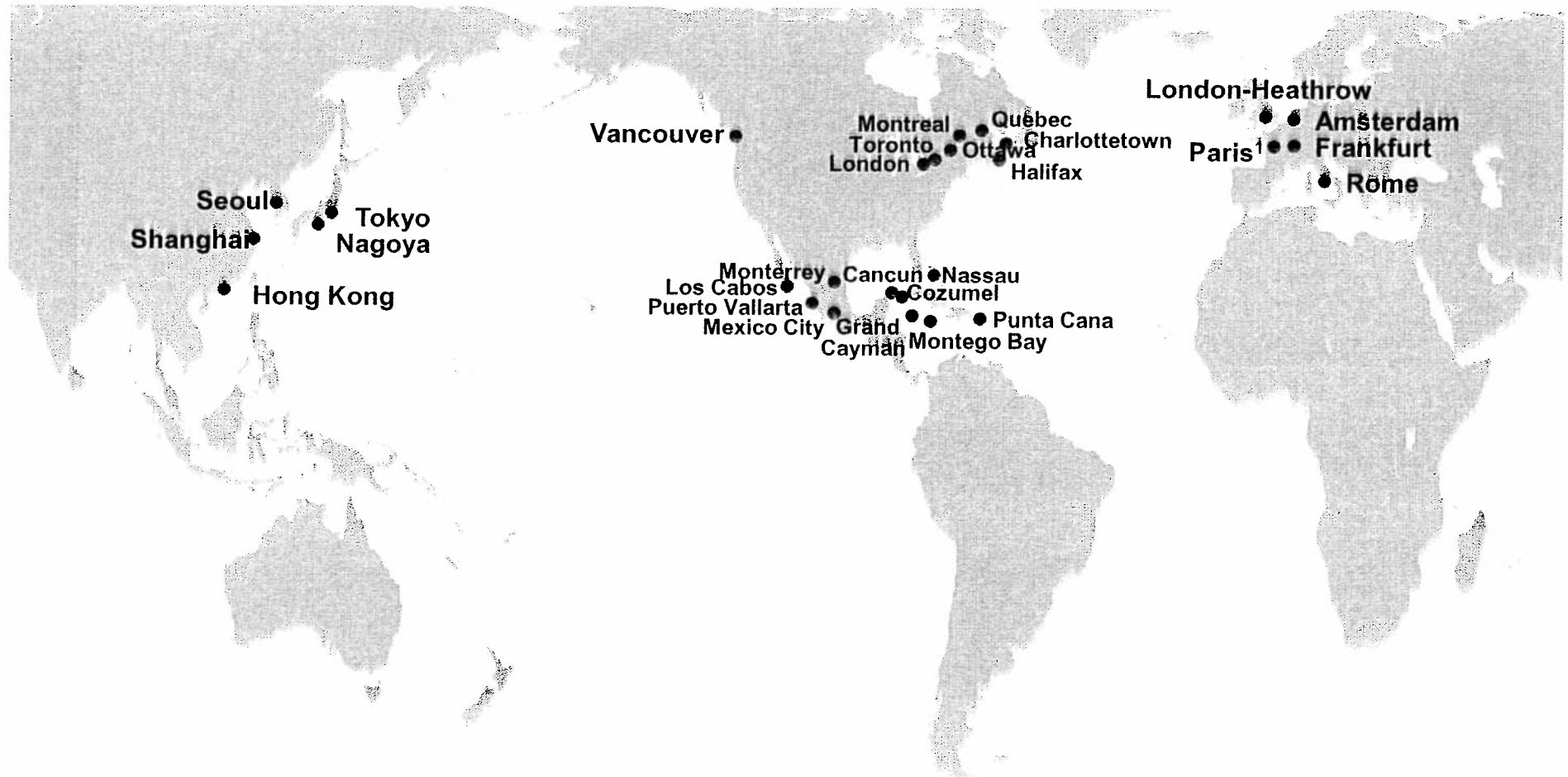
Delta Is A Michigan-Wide Operation

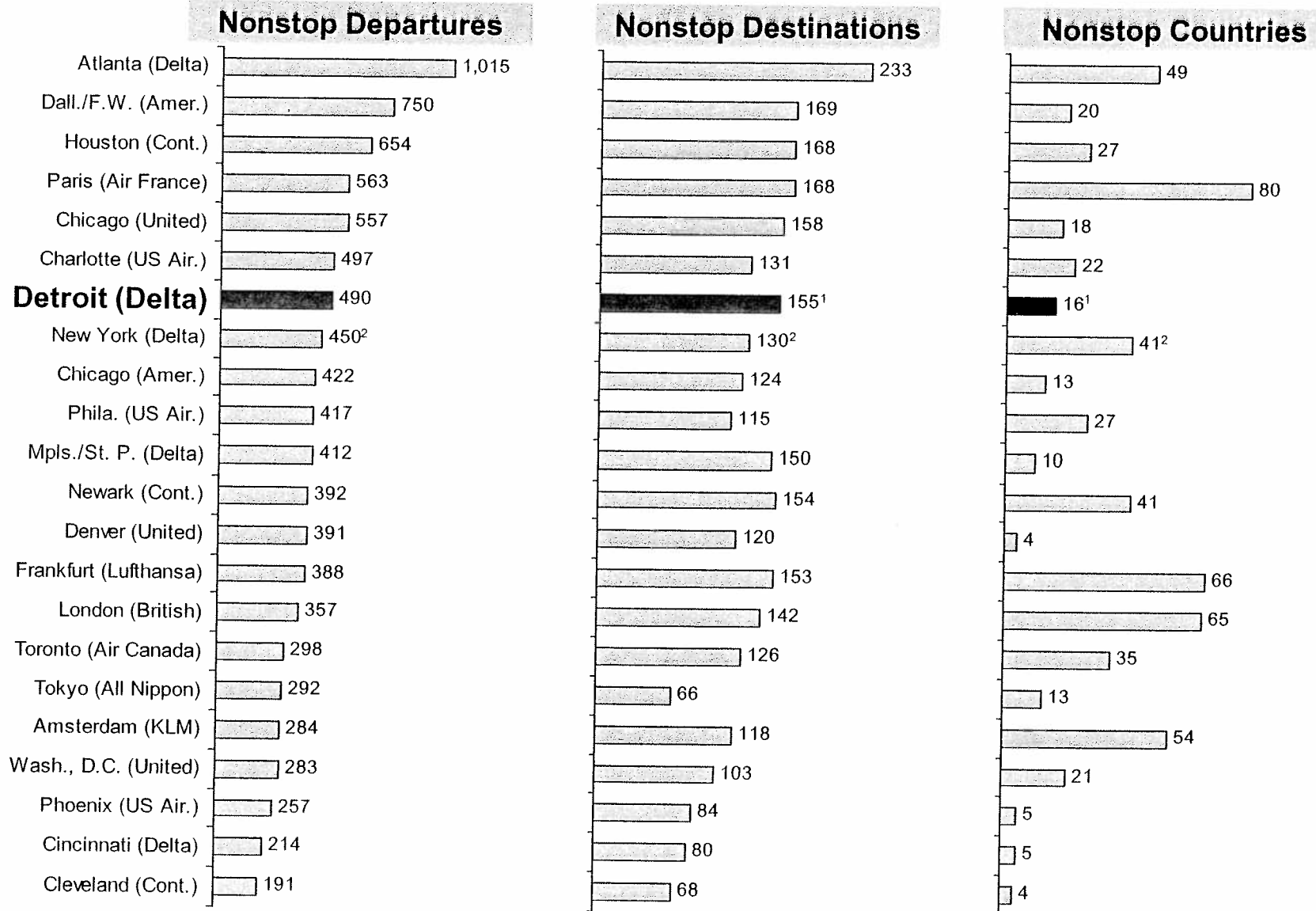
