HB-5555, As Passed House, December 8, 2009

HOUSE BILL No. 5555

October 27, 2009, Introduced by Rep. Clemente and referred to the Committee on New Economy and Quality of Life.

A bill to amend 1996 PA 376, entitled

"Michigan renaissance zone act,"

by amending section 3 (MCL 125.2683), as amended by 2008 PA 217.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

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Sec. 3. As used in this act:

(a) "Agricultural processing facility" means 1 or more
facilities or operations that transform, package, sort, or grade
livestock or livestock products, agricultural commodities, or
plants or plant products, excluding forest products, into goods
that are used for intermediate or final consumption including goods
for nonfood use, and surrounding property.

(b) "Board" means the state administrative board created in 1921 PA 2, MCL 17.1 to 17.3.

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(c) "Development plan" means a written plan that addresses the
 criteria in section 7 and includes all of the following:

3 (i) A map of the proposed renaissance zone that indicates the
4 geographic boundaries, the total area, and the present use and
5 conditions generally of the land and structures within those
6 boundaries.

7 (ii) Evidence of community support and commitment from8 residential and business interests.

9 (iii) A description of the methods proposed to increase economic
10 opportunity and expansion, facilitate infrastructure improvement,
11 and identify job training opportunities.

12 (*iv*) Current social, economic, and demographic characteristics 13 of the proposed renaissance zone and anticipated improvements in 14 education, health, human services, public safety, and employment if 15 the renaissance zone is created.

16 (v) Any other information required by the board.

17 (d) "Elected county executive" means the elected county
18 executive in a county organized under 1966 PA 293, MCL 45.501 to
19 45.521, or 1973 PA 139, MCL 45.551 to 45.573.

20 (e) "Forest products processing facility" means 1 or more 21 facilities or operations that transform, package, sort, recycle, or 22 grade forest or paper products into goods that are used for 23 intermediate or final use or consumption or for the creation of 24 biomass or alternative fuels through the utilization of forest products or forest residue, and surrounding property. Forest 25 26 products processing facility does not include an existing facility 27 or operation that is located in this state that relocates to a

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renaissance zone for a forest products processing facility. Forest
 products processing facility does not include a facility or
 operation that engages primarily in retail sales.

4 (f) "Local governmental unit" means a county, city, village,5 or township.

6 (g) "Person" means an individual, partnership, corporation,
7 association, limited liability company, governmental entity, or
8 other legal entity.

9 (h) "Qualified local governmental unit" means either of the10 following:

11 (*i*) A county.

(*ii*) A city, village, or township that contains an eligible
distressed area as defined in section 11 of the state housing
development authority act of 1966, 1966 PA 346, MCL 125.1411.

15 (i) "Recovery zone" means a tool and die renaissance recovery16 zone created in section 8d.

17 (j) "Renaissance zone" means a geographic area designated18 under this act.

19 (k) "Renewable energy facility" means a facility that creates 20 energy directly or fuel from the wind, the sun, trees, grasses, 21 biosolids, algae, agricultural commodities, processed products from 22 agricultural commodities, or residues from agricultural processes, 23 wood or forest processes, food production and processing, or the 24 paper products industry. Renewable energy facility also includes a 25 facility that creates energy or fuels from solid biomass, animal 26 wastes, or landfill gases. Renewable energy facility also includes 27 a facility that focuses on research, development, or manufacturing

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of systems or components of systems used to create energy or fuel
 from the items described in this subdivision. RENEWABLE ENERGY
 FACILITY ALSO INCLUDES A FACILITY THAT FOCUSES ON RESEARCH,
 DEVELOPMENT, OR MANUFACTURING OF SYSTEMS OR COMPONENTS OF SYSTEMS
 THAT INVOLVE THE CONVERSION OF CHEMICAL ENERGY FOR ADVANCED BATTERY
 TECHNOLOGY.

7 (l) "Residential rental property" means that term as defined in
8 section 7ff of the general property tax act, 1893 PA 206, MCL
9 211.7ff.

10 (m) "Review board" means the renaissance zone review board11 created in section 5.

12 (n) "Rural area" means an area that lies outside of the13 boundaries of an urban area.

14 (o) "Urban area" means an urbanized area as determined by the 15 economics and statistics administration, United States bureau of 16 the census according to the 1990 census.
