## **HOUSE BILL No. 6010**

March 25, 2010, Introduced by Reps. Lahti, Lindberg, McDowell, Espinoza and Terry Brown and referred to the Committee on Education.

A bill to amend 1968 PA 317, entitled

"An act relating to the conduct of public servants in respect to governmental decisions and contracts with public entities; to provide penalties for the violation of this act; to repeal certain acts and parts of acts; and to validate certain contracts,"

by amending section 3a (MCL 15.323a), as amended by 1996 PA 203.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 3a. Section 2 shall not be construed to do any of the 2 following:
- 3 (a) Prohibit public servants of a city, village, township, or
- 4 county with a population of less than 25,000 from serving, with or
- 5 without compensation, as emergency medical services personnel as
- 6 defined in section 20904 of the public health code, Act No. 368 of
- 7 the Public Acts of 1978, being section 333.20904 of the Michigan

- 1 (b) Prohibit public servants of a city, village, township, or
- 2 county with a population of less than 25,000 from serving, with or

- 7 (ii) A fire chief.
