SUBSTITUTE FOR

SENATE BILL NO. 1093

A bill to amend 1949 PA 300, entitled "Michigan vehicle code,"

by amending section 803i (MCL 257.803i), as amended by 1998 PA 68.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 803i. (1) A person who was or is a member of the national
- 2 guard may apply to the secretary of state for a special
- 3 registration plate, which shall display an appropriate vignette
- 4 preceding the registration numbers and shall have the words
- 5 "national guard" inscribed beneath the registration numbers.
- 6 (2) A person who was or is a member of the military reserve
- 7 may apply to the secretary of state for a special registration
- 8 plate, which shall display an appropriate vignette preceding the
- 9 registration numbers.
- 10 (3) A person who was a member of any branch of the armed

- 1 services of the United States, who has retired or been granted an
- 2 honorable discharge from that branch of the armed forces, and who
- 3 is not otherwise eligible for a special registration plate under
- 4 this act may apply to the secretary of state for a special
- 5 registration plate which shall display an appropriate vignette
- 6 preceding the registration numbers.
- 7 (4) A PERSON WHO WAS OR IS A MEMBER OF THE ARMY AIRBORNE MAY
- 8 APPLY TO THE SECRETARY OF STATE FOR A SPECIAL REGISTRATION PLATE,
- 9 WHICH SHALL DISPLAY AN APPROPRIATE VIGNETTE PRECEDING THE
- 10 REGISTRATION NUMBERS AND SHALL HAVE THE WORDS "ARMY AIRBORNE"
- 11 INSCRIBED BENEATH THE REGISTRATION NUMBERS.
- 12 (5) (4) Application for a special registration plate shall be
- on a form prescribed by the secretary of state and shall be
- 14 accompanied by any proof of the applicant being or having been a
- 15 member of the national quard, or military reserve, OR ARMY AIRBORNE
- 16 or a member of any branch of the armed services of the United
- 17 States as described in subsection (3) that the secretary of state
- 18 may require. The application for a special registration plate shall
- 19 also be accompanied with payment of a \$5.00 service fee.
- 20 (6) (5)—Upon proper application and payment of the \$5.00
- 21 service fee, the secretary of state shall issue 1 or more special
- 22 registration plates for each applicant for use on a passenger
- 23 vehicle. A person who is disabled who applies for a special
- 24 registration plate under this section and who pays the \$5.00
- 25 service fee shall be issued a tab for persons with disabilities as
- 26 provided in section 803f for his or her special registration plate.
- 27 The secretary of state shall require the same proof that the

- 1 applicant is a disabled person as is required for issuance of a
- 2 permanent windshield placard under section 675. A person issued 1
- 3 or more special registration plates under subsection (1), (2), or
- 4 (3), OR (4) shall be assessed the applicable tax provided in
- **5** section 801.
- 6 (7) (6) The use of a special registration plate on a vehicle
- 7 other than the vehicle for which the plate is issued, or by a
- 8 person who does not qualify under this section, is a misdemeanor.
- 9 (8) $\frac{(7)}{}$ The special registration plate issued under this
- 10 section shall expire on the birthday of the vehicle owner. When new
- 11 plates are issued by the secretary of state, application for
- 12 renewal of the special registration plate shall be accompanied by a
- 13 \$5.00 service fee. The applicant shall not be required to furnish
- 14 the proof provided in subsection $\frac{(4)}{(5)}$.
- 15 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act takes effect January
- **16** 1, 2011.
