- 1 (c) "Practice of marriage and family therapy" means the
- 2 providing of guidance, testing, discussions, therapy, instruction,
- 3 or advice that is intended to avoid, eliminate, relieve, manage, or

- 5 or restore marital or family harmony, or to prepare couples for
- 6 marriage. PRACTICE OF MARRIAGE AND FAMILY THERAPY INCLUDES
