- Sec. 3801. (1) Any A building, vehicle, boat, aircraft, or
 place IS A NUISANCE IF 1 OR MORE OF THE FOLLOWING APPLY:
 - (A) IT IS used for the purpose of lewdness, assignation, or prostitution or gambling. $\frac{1}{100}$
 - (B) IT IS used by, or kept for the use of, prostitutes or other disorderly persons. $\frac{1}{100}$
 - (C) IT IS used for the unlawful manufacture, transporting, sale, keeping for sale, bartering, or furnishing of any A controlled substance. as defined in section 7104 of the public
