

My name is David St. Amant. Eight years ago, May 30, 2003, I was in a car accident. I was air lifted to the hospital as fluid and blood drained through my ears and nose, totally unresponsive. After two and a half weeks in the hospital with no sign of emerging from the coma, it was suggested that I should be transferred to a custodial care facility. Not willing to give up, my parents transferred me to Mary Free Bed in Grand Rapids where I stayed for five months. My traumatic brain injury left me without muscle memory. I had to be taught how to open my mouth, swallow, talk and walk. Even my vision had to be relearned. Eight years later I continue to do therapies and I continue to improve. All this was made possible because of no-fault insurance.
