RE: The Michigan Messenger's "Appeal" of September 22, 2010 FOIA Fee & Deposit Notice to Mr. Todd Heywood's September 14, 2010 Freedom of Information Act Request

Dear Ms. Gurewitz and Messrs. Britton and Dass:

This is written in response to your January 10, 2011 letter addressed to Trustee Joel Ferguson, Chairperson of the MSU Board of Trustees, in which you seek to "appeal" our September 22, 2010 FOIA Fee & Deposit Notice regarding the labor fees estimated for processing the September 14, 2010 Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) request filed by Mr. Todd Heywood, reporter for the Michigan Messenger.

Section 10(1)(a) of the Michigan Freedom of Information Act (MIFOIA) provides that a requesting person may submit a written appeal *if a public body makes a final determination to deny a request.* See MCL 15.240(1) (emphasis added). You acknowledge in your "appeal" letter that our FOIA Fee & Deposit Notice did not deny Mr. Heywood's request. Your reliance on *Detroit Free Press, Inc v Dep't of Atty Gen*, 271 Mich App 418; 722 NW2d 277 (2006) in arguing "constructive denial" is improper. See *Detroit Free Press, supra* at 423, n.1 (the court of appeals states, "We reject the Free Press's argument that the Attorney General 'constructively denied' its request for the information by imposing \$60 in labor costs."). Accordingly, your "appeal" of a FOIA response that has not yet been made is premature and does not constitute a proper appeal under the MIFOIA.

Further, your characterization of our estimate of the labor costs involved in processing Mr. Heywood's request as "unjustifiably excessive and inconsistent" with the MIFOIA suggests that you are misinformed about the

nature and the amount of records responsive to the request. The MIFOIA allows MSU to charge for the cost of its search, examination, review and the deletion and separation of exempt from nonexempt information if the failure to charge a fee would result in unreasonably high costs to it. See MCL 15.234(3). The Michigan Attorney General has opined that Section 4(3) provides a "flexible standard of *unreasonably high costs*" to reflect "both the volume and the complexity of FOIA requests that a public body receives." 14 OAG, 2001, No 7083, p 20 (June 7, 2001). "If a FOIA request is made for an easily identified document consisting of a few standard size pages, labor for the search, examination, and making deletions under the FOIA would generally not present a case of unreasonably high costs to a public body." *Id.* "On the other hand, if a request is made for 'any and all' documents as to a particular subject, requires a search of many boxes of records, including review for exempt material which must be or may be deleted under section 13 of the FOIA, and if that search, examination, and review involves numerous hours of labor, a public body might well be justified in imposing charges to avoid the unreasonably high costs arising from the nature of that particular request." *Id.*

As explained in our FOIA Fee & Deposit Notice, the gather, examination and review of all records responsive to Mr. Heywood's request involves numerous hours of labor. The volume of records far exceeds the fourteen pages you erroneously presume exist in the files of the MSU Police Department. The nature of the records entails hours of review to separate information exempt from disclosure from that which is not exempt. Review and separation labor is a function of this Office. The lowest pay rate possible for the classification of employee capable of performing this work in our Office was used in calculating the fee estimate, as reflected in the FOIA Fee Estimate Calculation Worksheet. The labor costs incurred by the University for processing such a request would be unreasonably high if fees were not assessed.

Notwithstanding the foregoing, the records responsive to Mr. Heywood's request are enclosed. No fees will be assessed to Mr. Heywood for this processing. The said records were processed pursuant to a FOIA request for the same information from another individual who paid the required deposit. Personal information pertaining to individuals listed as witness, suspect or victim has been redacted under Sections 13(1)(a) and (b)(iii) of the MIFOIA. Photographs and medical records have also been withheld under these provisions. Section 13(1)(a) provides for the withholding of "information of a personal nature if public disclosure of the information would constitute a clearly unwarranted invasion of an individual's privacy." Section 13(1)(b) provides for the withholding of "investigating records compiled for law

enforcement purposes, but only to the extent that disclosure as a public record would do any of the following: . . . (iii) constitute an unwarranted invasion of personal privacy.”

The MIFOIA provides that when a public body denies all or a portion of a request, the requester may do one of the following: (1) submit an appeal of the determination to the head of the public body; or (2) commence an action in circuit court to compel the public body’s disclosure of the records. If you wish to seek judicial review of any denial, you must do so within 180 days of the date of this letter. If the circuit court orders disclosure of all or a portion of the public record(s) to which you have been denied access, you may receive attorneys’ fees and, in certain circumstances, damages under the MIFOIA.

Should you choose to file an appeal with the University regarding this response to Mr. Heywood’s request, you must submit a written communication to this Office expressly stating that it is an “appeal” of this response. All FOIA appeals received by the University are handled by the President, and not the MSU Board of Trustees. In your appeal, please state what records you believe should have been disclosed to you. You must also state the reasons you believe any denial of your MIFOIA request should be reversed. This Office will arrange for the processing and review of your appeal.

police report and if you would want you can write a statement based on what you have said tonight
and leave it for us and it goes to the Prosecutor's Office and they review it based on its merits.

KENNEDY: Your side of the story; her side of the story, they review the facts and the
circumstances and merits like the believability the credibility

KENNEDY: The complaint comes through as a sexual assault, in other words, there was [REDACTED]

[REDACTED] you know, you understand that. You're a young

KENNEDY: Well, you're part of the complaint, if you will.

KENNEDY: When I say complaint it's not so much...

KENNEDY: I think in totality, your understanding that [redacted]

Yeah, when [redacted]

KENNEDY: And that's why we are asking the questions we are this evening. We are trying to find out what happened and you are provided that statement. So we document this and a Prosecuting Attorney which is the Chief Law Enforcement Official in any county or city like a District Attorney reviews the report that we write and your statements and evaluates them, if you will, and makes a decision about what is believable and what really happened between the stories and the sides of the stories.

Okay, I see what you're saying.

KENNEDY: And, the facts as you relayed them as you saw them and what she, and [redacted] But that is where it sits and that is why we are here in the wee hours in the morning. It is a difficult job. It is a difficult circumstance and one that obviously you are concerned about.

Yeah, because I mean [redacted] So I mean, I just feel like [redacted] So I mean...

KENNEDY: Would you say that, although you said very clearly that [redacted]

Is that correct?

Yes.

KENNEDY: Okay, and this is partly why perhaps [redacted]

I understand what you are saying but I can see she [redacted]

and then she [redacted]

I mean, [redacted]

But she was like, [redacted]

like [redacted]

Like she [redacted]

KENNEDY: So you could see where [REDACTED]

[REDACTED] But I mean, it is [REDACTED] because I mean if you can [REDACTED]

We will be in touch with you. I can get a business card and leave that for you so you can get a hold of me if needed. I'll do that right now. Any other questions for myself or Detective Simi?

[REDACTED] Yeah I do but I just can't think of any right now.

KENNEDY: That's why we are giving you the business cards to contact us.

SIMI: If there is anything else you think of after that you can either contact us or...

[REDACTED] Umm, what do I do from here? Like I go home and go to sleep?

KENNEDY: Yup and you'll hear because.

[REDACTED] You'll contact me again.

KENNEDY: Right we write the report and that takes time to put things together.

[REDACTED] So then if something else pops up then I have to get back here?

KENNEDY: Well perhaps it depends and really what happens is we document this and we write it up as it is. And we forward it to the Prosecuting Attorney and like I said they review it and decide the merits or how they feel about the case.

[REDACTED] By the merits and what they are going to do about me and him.

KENNEDY: Right.

[REDACTED] So where do you all come up with where we are right now. You understand, I don't have nothing to do. I'm not [REDACTED] So what is happening to [REDACTED] that is not happening to me? Does that make it any different?

KENNEDY: You're demonstrating right now willingness to cooperative and make statements and provide your side of the story and we document that and we forward that to the Prosecutor and they review that. He is not making any statements. Is that a good decision or a bad decision?

[REDACTED] That ain't a good decision. I'm just flat out going to tell you.

KENNEDY: So, it is their decision. The ball is out of our court. I think you can understand that? I'm just trying to [REDACTED] It is not in our court anymore. It's in their court. They decide what happens from here.

[REDACTED] So, they decide what happens to me.

KENNEDY: Yes.

SIMI: It's not like you guys are grouped together.

[REDACTED] So besides what she saying, [REDACTED]

KENNEDY: We don't get into the details about that and you can understand that. Our interest in having you here tonight is what you had to say and what your side of the story is. And we would write your side of the story down, and we will, like hers. So we just write down what we're told. And we record things and provide them that way so it is an exact replica of what you said and not my interpretation of what you have said. Does that help?

like, all right, [REDACTED] and I live in [REDACTED]

MAPLEY: Around what time did [REDACTED] and [REDACTED]

[REDACTED] Little after 2:30, 2:40.

MAPLEY: 2:30, 2:40ish? Does that sound right?

[REDACTED] Yeah, I have [REDACTED]

[REDACTED] I [REDACTED] when I [REDACTED] I [REDACTED] when I [REDACTED]
[REDACTED] didn't I?

[REDACTED] Yeah.

MAPLEY: Did you continue to [REDACTED] or did you [REDACTED] when [REDACTED]

[REDACTED] It was 2:40 when [REDACTED]

MAPLEY: Okay.

[REDACTED] Umm, when I [REDACTED]

MAPLEY: Did you [REDACTED]

[REDACTED] Yeah, I [REDACTED] but she told me not to.

MAPLEY: Okay, good, good, good. Okay, so you [REDACTED] Those are still [REDACTED] though. You know where they are?

[REDACTED] Yeah, they're [REDACTED]

MAPLEY: You did not [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] around 2:40. Where did you guys go from there?

[REDACTED] [REDACTED]

[REDACTED] We went to [REDACTED]

MAPLEY: Did you guys go to, like, [REDACTED]

[REDACTED] Yeah.

[REDACTED] I had [REDACTED] and asked, you know, what to do. Do I [REDACTED] you know. So, that's what they said.

MAPLEY: Okay. Do you guys have any of the [REDACTED] with you that has anything about, like which [REDACTED] or who you [REDACTED] or who [REDACTED]

[REDACTED] Well like when I [REDACTED] they [REDACTED] That's who I talked to. That was like [REDACTED]

MAPLEY: Okay, so [REDACTED] LAUREN, LAUREN ALLSWEDE.

[REDACTED] Yeah.

MAPLEY: LAUREN ALLSWEDE is the [REDACTED] This is the MSU Counseling Center? Was she at [REDACTED]

[REDACTED] They called her in.

MAPLEY: Oh, they called her in to [REDACTED]

[REDACTED] But she works, she works on [REDACTED]

MAPLEY: Do you mind if I make a copy of this so that you can keep it?

[REDACTED] That's fine.

MAPLEY: We'll set this aside so I can make a copy of it. Umm okay, do you have any of the other [REDACTED] or...

[REDACTED] That was from the [REDACTED] I don't know if you can read it. She's the one that did it.

MAPLEY: So this is all...

[REDACTED] I don't think there is anything else with a name on it.

[REDACTED] The stuff that you signed. The lady took it back, you know, like, the [REDACTED] and you know, the lady who [REDACTED] I guess. That was at the front desk.

[REDACTED] Yeah, that's all we have with names.

MAPLEY: Do you remember if they said [REDACTED] Like [REDACTED] whatever?

[REDACTED] I don't know.

[REDACTED] LAUREN [REDACTED] Yeah, because I kind of, I think, do you think she [REDACTED] asking [REDACTED].

MAPLEY: They may have. Do you mind if I make a copy of this here, just so that I have a copy of that.

[REDACTED] I don't remember what her name was because I looked at the end because I realized, like, [REDACTED] I never knew her name.

MAPLEY: Yeah, I can understand that.

[REDACTED] And then I did the same thing with LAUREN but I remembered her name.

MAPLEY: All right. So, I'll make a copy of that too just so I can try to figure out who that is, okay? What did, what did they do for you [REDACTED] I mean, did they say they were [REDACTED]

[REDACTED] Yeah, it was...

MAPLEY: Is that what they told you?

[REDACTED] Yeah because they had asked me what, you know, how I [REDACTED] like the [REDACTED] and, you know all that. And then if I wanted to report it, but I didn't know what I [REDACTED] and so they said, [REDACTED]

MAPLEY: Okay, so they [REDACTED] and then they are probably just hanging on to it?

[REDACTED] Yes.

MAPLEY: Okay, that is good. So we can, umm, so they basically told you, you know, [REDACTED]

[REDACTED] Yeah.

MAPLEY: Did you have, did you have any injuries that [REDACTED] Any [REDACTED] anything that you remember or that you're still, that you're still in pain from?

I do need to go with you back [REDACTED] If that's okay, to collect the clothes that you were wearing that night; because they may have DNA evidence on them from those guys and that's going to [REDACTED] So is that okay that I come with you to go pick that stuff up?

MAPLEY: And, again, if you [REDACTED] nobody needs to know why. I'm not going to say anything, if you don't want to say anything. You know, this, everything that goes on here right now is just between us and anyone else that helps investigate the case. So, you know, I know a lot of this stuff is really uncomfortable for you, but it's not going to be shared outside of here.

MAPLEY: Okay. What's a good phone number for you?

(OFC MAPLEY LEAVES ROOM)

(OFC MAPLEY RE-ENTERS ROOM)

MAPLEY: Sorry about that, guys.

MAPLEY: So, you asked her what happened.

[REDACTED] What happened, and the only thing that I could make out was, she said, umm, [REDACTED]

MAPLEY: Okay.

[REDACTED] Umm, you know at that point, I said, [REDACTED] You know, I said, [REDACTED] And umm after probably, like, three or four minutes of [REDACTED] you know, she [REDACTED] I finally got her to [REDACTED] and you know they were [REDACTED]

MAPLEY: Okay.

MAPLEY: Okay.

MAPLEY: Okay, [REDACTED] you don't know [REDACTED]

[REDACTED] (Shaking head in no fashion)

MAPLEY: [REDACTED] And how did you [REDACTED] or do you know [REDACTED]

MAPLEY: So they [REDACTED]

[REDACTED] Yeah.

[REDACTED] And didn't they [REDACTED], and you told them [REDACTED]

MAPLEY: And what time did you say [REDACTED] Give me a rough guesstimate?

UNNAMED FEMALE: It was before you [REDACTED]

MAPLEY: How long before you [REDACTED]

[REDACTED] Umm, I was [REDACTED] so I can kinda tell.

MAPLEY: Where did you feel [REDACTED] and all this was happening?
Still [REDACTED] Were you [REDACTED]

[REDACTED] [REDACTED]

MAPLEY: Okay, so what time roughly do you think [REDACTED] You can give me a guess.

[REDACTED] [REDACTED]

MAPLEY: [REDACTED] You said that you thought like you probably [REDACTED]

[REDACTED]

[REDACTED] Maybe earlier.

MAPLEY: Or, sometime like between [REDACTED]

[REDACTED] Yeah, I think it was.

MAPLEY: When you guys were [REDACTED] and you guys were [REDACTED] when you guys [REDACTED]
[REDACTED] did you pretty much [REDACTED]

[REDACTED] Yes.

MAPLEY: That will be important for when we start [REDACTED] I don't know if you believe me but I think that is all the questions that I have for you. I apologize. I know that this is kind of long drawn out thing. Being thorough is [REDACTED]

[REDACTED] Let me get you a report number here for you. Do you guys have any questions for me? Anything that you feel like maybe I didn't ask or cover or anything that you think might be helpful?

[REDACTED] I guess I have questions just because I'm somewhat involved with the [REDACTED] and I've heard that which [REDACTED] and why hasn't anything you know happened; if the victims didn't come you know go to the hospital, didn't want to press charges, like you know, that sort of thing. And also for her safety [REDACTED] and when she is [REDACTED] what's her protection? You know because you are on the police end doing the investigation with these guys and we have [REDACTED] and you know how they are, you know they could harass and things like that. I'm also worried about that.

MAPLEY: What I'll do, I'll go talk to my supervisors and I'll get some different information for you and resources that you can go to. There is one place on campus called Safe Place. I don't know if you have heard about that.

[REDACTED] She was telling me about that.

MAPLEY: Safe Place is an awesome resource. They are an incredible resource. It's one of those things where you feel the need to get out of your [REDACTED] for a little bit and have a place to escape to, Safe Place is a secret location on Campus that nobody knows about but you until you get there and so if you feel you need somewhere to go to cool off for a little bit, they'll will help accommodate you. They have tons of resources and like I said, you know, now that you have filed this report the way that we will investigate it is going to be hard and fast. We are going to jump on these guys and [REDACTED] or not, I have no respect for them after what they did and there's not going to be pulling any punches or anything like that. No one deserves [REDACTED] especially not with something as absurd as this.

[REDACTED] I think the faster that it happens doesn't [REDACTED]

MAPLEY: I agree. I 100% agree. Like I said, this is going to be; I'm going to do some more of my own follow up tonight. I may not talk to them yet tonight because I don't want them to know. I may wait until our Detective Bureau can sit them down and you know maybe hook them up with a polygraph or whatever else they are going to do. But like I said, it's just going to be hard and fast as best as I can make it.

[REDACTED] I have a concern about like obviously at some point [REDACTED] but like [REDACTED] I don't want my name out there.

[REDACTED] Well it's [REDACTED]

MAPLEY: I think their [REDACTED] I don't think that its, they are [REDACTED]

[REDACTED] But they [REDACTED] you know.

[REDACTED] They were [REDACTED]

[REDACTED] You know, so for her [REDACTED]

[REDACTED] I'm just worried about my name getting out.

MAPLEY: Right, the way that this works and people understand that this is a pretty sensitive thing, you know, I can't make any promises that I can't keep and I don't know exactly. I know that they are going to do everything they can do to protect your privacy but the media they are kind of heartless bastards. I'll be honest. I can't make any promises but again I will talk to my supervisors and we will see what we can do about making sure that this flies under the radar for your own protection. I don't think [REDACTED] and I'm sure you know [REDACTED]

[REDACTED] So, that may be in everybody best interest, one for [REDACTED] and especially more importantly for you. Let me finish writing this number down real quick.

[REDACTED] Also we haven't [REDACTED] At what point do you think that would be a good idea and just because [REDACTED] you know obviously still very [REDACTED] and stuff like that.

MAPLEY: In my personal opinion, I'm not sure what [REDACTED] is like but you know, it is not a matter of telling the whole world but if you tell people that you trust that can be there in the support base that will be a lot better than holding it inside and trying to deal with it yourself. You know we have resources, we have people that you can talk too. If you aren't comfortable talking [REDACTED] about it. But this isn't anything that you need to be ashamed of. You [REDACTED] so you know, like I said, this is one of those things like if you have that support base from people that you care about that can be there for you; that are able and willing to talk to you about it. I think that is going to make things a lot easier for you [REDACTED] in your own mind this may never go away but working past it with people you know and love and that care about you will be a huge healing point. My personal opinion the sooner the better but that would all be about when you are comfortable doing it and sharing it with them.

When I go talk to the people that were with you that night, they are not going to know anything about what happened. If you want to start thinking about what you want to tell them, if they ask, why was I talking to them about you, that is up to you. You can decide, you know, whatever you want to decide. I'm not going to tell them anything about it, but again, being able to establish that you [REDACTED] is so important to this and keeping you as a witness so that [REDACTED] that you say that I just can't ignore that and not talk to them.

[REDACTED] Yeah, absolutely.

MAPLEY: So, I will tread very lightly and I give you my word that I will be very careful about it so you don't have to worry about that from that end but if you want to start thinking about, you know, if they ask you, what you want to say to them; just say don't worry about it. Let me make some photocopies of this and let me talk to my supervisor. This is the report number. You want to hang on to that. This is my business card. With taking this report, this isn't where it ends between you and I. If you have questions and you need to get a hold of me for any reason, email is the best way. I have

email on my personal phone so that I can check it at anytime. I never check my voicemail or my voicemail here so if you call it you won't hear from me for like ten days. I usually work night shift, 6pm to 6am. If you need anything or if there is anything you want to add or if you have any questions, anything you can get a hold of me. Give me just a couple of minutes and I will be right back to you guys and we will head on over to [REDACTED] and grab that stuff and I'll be out of your hair and you can chill out for the rest of the night.

[REDACTED] Do you have a restroom I can use.

MAPLEY: Yes, absolutely.

(SGT AGUILERA HAS ENTERED THE ROOM)

AGUILERA: I'm SGT AGUILERA, by the way, my name is MIKE. you can call me MIKE. I'm going to ask you to stick around for just a few more minutes because there are a couple of more things that we have to do. We are going to need to get those [REDACTED] for evidentiary purposes so we are going to be sending either OFFICER MAPLEY or somebody else over with you to get those [REDACTED] so we can properly secure them. I'm going to ask you to stick around a couple of more minutes. We need to get our ducks in row and we want to do it right. We do not want to do any disservice to you. We want to do it in the proper way so hold tight for a few more minutes and we will be back for you.

MAPLEY: It 's okay for her to use the bathroom?

AGUILERA: Yes.

(SGT AGUILERA AND OFC MAPLEY HAVE LEFT THE ROOM)

[REDACTED] HAS LEFT THE ROOM TO USE THE BATHROOM)

[REDACTED] REMAINS IN ROOM)

[REDACTED] RE-ENTER THE ROOM)

(OFC MAPLEY ENTERS ROOM)

MAPLEY: These are the originals here are the copies.

[REDACTED] When we go to her [REDACTED] to get her [REDACTED] are you guys coming in or can she bring them out to you? She doesn't want people to see you in your clothes.

MAPLEY: We have one of our officers that is in plain clothes today. He is not wearing a uniform, so maybe we'll have him come in and do it. The most important thing is for the chain of evidence. We want to be able to say, "yeah we collected, bagged it" and all that. Let me talk to my SERGEANT about that and see if we can get an answer.

(OFFICER MAPLEY LEAVES ROOM)

(SGT AGUILERA ENTERS ROOM)

AGUILERA: I don't want to keep you here anymore longer than you want to be. My supervisors are bringing in some detectives, that are expected shortly. I don't know if you want to stick around but I don't have a need to keep around but what I need you to do is to be on call for me because we are going to be talking to those guys, we are going to be doing a couple of things and I need to know if I can I get a hold of you basically 24/7 because if something happens, you know, something changes we need to clarify so we might need to recontact you. It may be later tonight or It may be early tomorrow, is that cell phone number that OFFICER MAPLEY has is that the best way?

[REDACTED] Yeah.

AGUILERA: All I can say is if you get a call or someone leaves you a message from us, you won't have a problem giving us a call back no matter what time it is. This way I don't have to keep you here.

MAPLEY: The best number to call us back is 517-355-2222. That rings into the 24 hour desk cadet up front. They are here all night so no matter when you call if you don't have a number to call us back that is the best one.

AGUILERA: For right now we are pretty much all done but we need to get those [REDACTED] and you and I understand that you want to keep this low profile. TIM said we are hear 24/7 so just let us know what we can do for you. Tonight I can of need you to be on call and especially tomorrow. Do you plan on going anywhere today?
