MINUTES

The Senate Committee on Education held a meeting on Wednesday, October 19, 2011, at 12:00 p.m. in the Senate Hearing Room, Ground Floor, Boji Tower. Senator Pavlov called the meeting to order at 12:18 p.m.

Senator Pavlov announced the order of business for the Education Committee:

- Adoption of October 12, 2011, minutes
- SB 622 Sen. Emmons Education; students; dual enrollment eligibility; modify in postsecondary options act.
- SB 623 Sen. Emmons Education; students; dual enrollment eligibility; modify in career and technical preparation act.
- SB 709 Sen. Emmons Education; students; dual enrollment opportunities for high school students in career and technical preparation programs; expand to nonpublic school and home school students.
- SB 710 Sen. Emmons Education; students; dual enrollment opportunities for high school students in certain postsecondary institutions; expand to nonpublic school and home-schooled students.
