MINUTES
Senate Committee on Outdoor Recreation and Tourism

A meeting of the Senate Committee on Outdoor Recreation and Tourism was held on Wednesday, December 5, 2012 at 9:00 a.m. in Room 405 of the Capitol Building.

The meeting was called to order at 9:09 a.m.

Members present: Senators Hansen, Hildenbrand, Casperson, Moolenaar, and Young
Members excused: Senator Meekhof, and Gleason

Senator Hansen called the meeting to order.

Senator Hansen announced the order of business for the day:

- Approval of Minutes
- HB 5415 (Rep. Foster) Recreation; local parks; Father Marquette national memorial and Mackinac straits area museum advisory board; establish.

Senator Casperson moved to adopt the minutes from November 8, 2012 with unanimous consent. Without objection, the minutes were adopted.

Senator Hansen placed before the committee House Bill 5415 (Rep. Foster). Jason Pucas, staff of Representative Foster, explained the bill to committee members and answered questions.

The following people testified on House Bill 5415 and answered questions from committee members:

Senator Hildenbrand moved that House Bill 5415 be reported out of committee with the recommendation that the bill then pass. The motion prevailed by an affirmative vote of a majority of the members appointed to and serving on the committee, voting as follows:

Senator Hansen moved to recommend immediate effect for House Bill 5415. By unanimous consent, the committee further recommended that the bill be given immediate effect.

Senator Hansen adjourned the committee at 9:20 a.m.
