

Michigan NWTf Hunting Heritage State Super Fund Projects – \$3,153,058

Since 1985 NWTf volunteers in Michigan have raised and spent **\$3,153,058** on projects within the state, including:

Upland Wildlife Habitat Enhancement [\$1,664,540]

...to complete upland wildlife habitat improvement projects that have impacted more than 67,162 acres within the state.

Education [\$590,341]

...to provide educational programs and literature including scholarships, education boxes, 4-H and teacher workshops, plus educational projects for volunteers and professionals.

Outreach Events [\$396,389]



...to introduce youth, women and people with disabilities to outdoor activities, conservation and hunting through JAKES, Women in the Outdoors and Wheelin' Sportsmen NWTf outreach programs. Sponsored 675 outreach events throughout the state.

Hunting Heritage [\$148,975]

...to protect and promote the hunting tradition by contributing to the U.S. Sportsmen's Alliance and the National Shooting Sports Foundation.

Wild Turkey Management [\$43,070]

...to manage wild turkey populations by operating check stations, conducting hunter success and satisfaction surveys, completing wild turkey management plans and purchasing equipment to support law enforcement and resource management activities.

Hunter Safety [\$36,900]

...to support hunter safety classes and initiatives within the state by purchasing hunter safety materials and equipment, including interactive shooting systems.

Habitat Enhancement

Goal Support efforts on Michigan's three national forests to maintain and improve early successional wildlife habitats.

Goal Support prescribed fire efforts on state and federal agency lands across Michigan.

Goal Continue to establish winter wildlife food sources by planting fruit-bearing trees, shrubs and annual grains, especially in snow-belt country.

Goal Increase openings on all national forests, on a forest-wide scale.

Goal Make comments concerning habitat enhancement on agency lands as projects are proposed.

Goal Support management projects suggested by the Michigan Department of Natural Resources with the use of dedicated turkey dollars.

Outreach and Education

Goal Encourage every local NWTf chapter to hold outreach programs for youth, women and people with disabilities through the NWTf's JAKES, Women in the Outdoors and Wheelin' Sportsmen outreach programs.

Goal Support at least two Wild Turkey Woodlands programs within Michigan each year.

Goal Furnish at least one NWTf Wild About Turkey Education Box to each chapter annually.

Goal Offer each local chapter monetary support to fund a scholarship.

Hunter Heritage

Goal Support the shooting sports other than 4-H, which can include groups like Boy Scouts and Girl Scouts, etc.

Goal Support the the 4-H shooting sports at local and state levels.

Goal Contribute annually to the National Archery in the Schools Program.

Goal Support the U.S. Sportsmen's Alliance on an annual basis.

Goal Support of pro-hunting issues as they arise in Michigan.
