MINUTES

The Senate Committee on Transportation held a meeting on Tuesday, October 11, 2011, at 12:30 p.m. in Room 100 of the Farnum Building. Senator Casperson called the meeting to order at 12:45 p.m.

Attendance was recorded as follows:

Senator Casperson announced the following order of business:

- Adoption of the October 4, 2011, minutes
- SB 516 Sen. Proos Vehicles; agricultural equipment; definition of modified agriculture vehicle; create, and provide an exception from certain weight requirements.
- HB 4642 Rep. McBroom Traffic control; traffic regulation; definition of authorized emergency vehicle; amend to include privately owned vehicles of an emergency management unit.
- HB 4888 Rep. McBroom Highways; name; certain bridge on US-141; designate as the "Veterans Memorial Bridge".

Senator Casperson led the members in the Pledge of Allegiance.

Senator Casperson requested a motion to adopt the minutes from October 4, 2011. Senator Brandenburg offered the motion; being no objection, the motion prevailed.

Senator Casperson announced Senate Bill 516 was being removed from the agenda for further work.

Senator Casperson announced the next order of business was House Bill 4642. As the sponsor of the measure, Representative McBroom gave the members a brief explanation.

Mike Sands, representing Delta County Search and Rescue, spoke in support of the bill.

This was the first week the bill had been brought before the members so testimony was taken and the legislation was held over for voting at a later date.

Senator Casperson announced the next order of business was House Bill 4888. As the sponsor of the measure, Representative McBroom gave the members a brief explanation.

Senator Casperson gave an explanation of the substitute language in the S-1.

The Chair took a brief recess at 1:56 p.m.

The Chair resumed the meeting at 1:04 p.m.

Senator Casperson announced Senator Hansen was being added to the committee as a permanent member.

Being no further testimony, Senator Kowall made a motion to adopt the S-1 version of House Bill 4888.
