

The permittee shall indemnify and save harmless the Transportation Commission, the department and all of their employees from any and all suits, claims, and damages of every kind arising out of, under or by reason of this permit, or from operations covered by this permit.
- The driver of the vehicle shall carry the permit in the vehicle to which it applies and shall have it available for inspection by any police officer or agent of the Department of Transportation. The driver shall stop at all highway weigh stations for permit inspection.
- Insurance coverage required in the law of this state shall be in effect for moves operating with an over weight or over size permit.
- Any of the following actions shall immediately void the permit and subject the applicant to appropriate legal action:
  - Misrepresentation of information set forth in an application for permit.
  - Any operation on state trunkline highways beyond the size or weight limitations shown on permit.
  - A change or erasure on a permit.
- Permits are not valid for periods extending beyond the expiration date. Extended permits will not be issued for a period of less than a year.






