

### SEED Students in Michigan


*We need a law that defines students eligible for a college-prep boarding school.*

**To be eligible, a student must:**

- Attend school in a participating school district
- Be at risk of academic failure
- Be from a family whose income is below 200%

**And meet at least two of the following additional conditions:**

- Have a record of in-school disciplinary actions.
- Have not attained proficiency in state assessments in reading, or math
- Be a child with a disability.
- Be referred for academic intervention services
- Live in a single-parent household, or in a home whose head of household is not the student's custodial parent.
- Have an immediate family member who is or has been incarcerated.




### Expansion: Factors

*To establish a new school, SEED must successfully develop six elements of support.*

Success Factor	Objective
<b>Community Support</b>	• Conduct hundreds of interviews to develop support among families, community organizations and educational, nonprofit, religious, and government leaders
<b>Operational Funding</b>	• Secure long-term, sustainable funding from public sources
<b>Private Funding</b>	• Identify individual, foundation, and corporate philanthropists to fund facility and school start-up costs
<b>Site Selection</b>	• Identify sites that can accommodate academic, residential, and recreational facilities & which SEED can control and develop
<b>Financing</b>	• Identify financing mechanisms & negotiate underwriting
<b>Leadership</b>	• Secure talented individuals to develop & operate school


## SEED School Operating Revenues

The SEED model requires additional funds to support 24-hour operations. Both D.C. and Maryland have passed legislation to provide this funding.
