On May 8, 1975, our Son was involved in an accident that has changed all of our lives. My Son, Brian, had a Chevelle and was going down US 12, when the head lights went out. He pulled the car off to the side of the road and walked across the street to ask for help and on his way back to his car was hit by a car traveling that stretch of road.

He was taken to St. Joseph Hospital immediately to get the care that he needed. The Drs told us that if he lived, he would never be the same. He spent 90 days in ICU, and at that point, they told us they couldn't do anymore. We rented an apartment for him and a helper that would attend to his needs. We took him to a facility, but while he was there, his leg was broken couple of times. We took him to Denver to a facility, searching for the best place to keep him safe. We even placed him in a Medicare facility, which was a farce, items were stolen and his care was not good. The insurance company told us to get a house and they would have it remodeled for him and his care person. Some time had passed and the insurance company said that they, the aides, weren't RNs and so liabilities were too great, he would have to be placed in a facility for his needs to be met.

Insurance company showed us many places, but Eisenhower Center was the best fit for our Brian. Without Auto-No-Fault this would not have been made possible.
