I had several broken bones and was left with a paralyzed left arm. I also survived a TBI. It is by God's grace that I am alive. I would be homeless and have no way to support myself adequately. I have been able to get the medical care I needed thanks to Auto No Fault Insurance. I was in the hospital for 4 months. I then came to Eisenhower. I have been here for 4 years. I take therapies every day that have helped me dramatically with my close head injury. I also go to physical therapy where I have regained partial use of my arm. When I was in the hospital they wanted to amputate my arm because the nerves were detached at the spinal cord. No Fault Insurance fostered a home of hope for my paralyzed arm. I also have a job at Brookdale. It is an assisted living facility. I am going to start college in the winter semester. Without Auto No Fault my life would be a complete disaster. I would not have all these opportunities or live a complete successful life. I am Bipolar and I have learned that taking my medicines, sleeping and eating are imperative for having a functional life. Without Auto No Fault I would not have lived a stable life and learned that there are red flags for me. I have been in and out of psychiatric hospitals but because of Auto No Fault I have lived in a structured environment. This is very emotionally healthy for me as an individual. Please keep Auto No Fault. Each individual has a powerful recovery story because of you. Try to look at our Lives not the numbers. Thank you so much for the life I am now living. I really appreciate it and you time.
