

Military Family Relief Fund

- The fund, established in law (PA 363 of 2004), receives donations from Michigan citizens completing their state income tax returns.
- The fund provides financial assistance to National Guard and Reserve Components personnel and their families who have been deployed at least 30 days.


Military Family Relief Fund Program Requirements

- The individual is a member of the reserve components of the United States armed forces based in the State of Michigan.
- The individual is a resident of the State of Michigan serving in a reserve component of the United States armed forces based in another state.
- The individual is called to active duty by the President of the United States or the United States Secretary of Defense as a result of the national response to September 11, 2001.
- Document the need for financial assistance.

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
- The financial need must have occurred during the time the individual was on active duty or the need occurred because the individual incurred a line of duty injury or illness.
- The qualified individual incurred a significant increase in the necessities of daily living.
- The qualified individual suffered a significant emergency that warrants financial assistance.
