## Minutes

A meeting of the Senate Appropriations Committee was held on Wednesday, September 17, 2014 at 2:01 pm on the 3<sup>rd</sup> floor of the Capitol Building.

A motion to excuse all absent members was made by Senator Booher and supported by Senator Pappageorge.

Senator Kahn gave his opening remarks regarding order of business:

- SB 792 (Sen. Proos) State financing and management; budget; governor's executive budget; require to include reporting of unfunded accrued liabilities.

- SB 1016 (Sen. Kahn) Transportation; funds; transportation economic development fund; extend fiscal year funding for the state trunk line fund.
