MINUTES

A meeting of the Senate Economic Development Committee was held on Wednesday, February 27, 2013, at 1:30 p.m. in Room 110 of the Farnum Building.

The meeting was called to order at 1:30 p.m.

Members Present: Senators Kowall (C), Hildenbrand, Nofs, Emmons, Hansen

Members Excused: Senators Hunter, Smith

Senator Kowall called the meeting to order.

Senator Hansen motioned, supported by Senator Nofs, that the committee adopt the minutes of February 21, 2013. Without objection, the motion prevailed by unanimous voice.

Senator Kowall announced the order of business:

- SB 146 (Sen. Young) Economic development; neighborhood enterprise zones; neighborhood enterprise zone eligibility; expand.

Senator Emmons entered the committee room at 1:32 p.m.

Senator Kowall placed before the committee Senate Bill 146 (Sen. Young) for testimony. Senator Young and his staff explained the bill to committee members and answered questions.
