Senate Committee on Judiciary
Minutes

A meeting of the Senate Committee on Judiciary was held on Tuesday, January 21, 2013 at 2:00 p.m. in Room 110 of the Farnum Building.

The meeting was called to order at 2:06 p.m.

- SB 572 (Sen. Booher) – Weapons; other; carrying of electromuscular disruption devices by certain individuals in weapon-free zones; provide for.
- SB 573 (Sen. Casperson) – Weapons; other; sentencing guidelines; update certain references.
