April 18, 2013

A meeting of the Senate Committee on Regulatory Reform was scheduled for Thursday, April 18, 2013, at 1:00 p.m., in Room 210 of the Farnum Building.

The agenda summary is as follows:

- 2) SB 79 (S-6) reported with recommendation and immediate effect.
- 3) SB 279 reported with recommendation and immediate effect.
