MINUTES

The Senate Committee on Transportation held a meeting on Tuesday, October 15, 2013 at 12:30 p.m. in Room 100 of the Farnum Building.

Senator Casperson called the meeting to order at 12:30 p.m.

Senator Casperson announced the following order of business:

- Adoption of the minutes from the October 8, 2013 meeting
