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## **HOUSE BILL No. 5196**

December 12, 2013, Introduced by Rep. Lori and referred to the Committee on Education.

A bill to amend 1976 PA 451, entitled "The revised school code,"

by amending section 1502 (MCL 380.1502), as amended by 1993 PA 335.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- Sec. 1502. (1) Health and EACH PUBLIC SCHOOL SHALL ESTABLISH AND PROVIDE HEALTH EDUCATION AND physical education for pupils of 2 both sexes. shall be established and provided in all public schools 3
- of this state. Subject to subsection (2), each EACH pupil attending 4
- 5 public school in this state who is physically fit and capable of
- doing so shall take the course in physical education. 6
  - (2) ALL OF THE FOLLOWING APPLY TO PHYSICAL EDUCATION UNDER THIS SECTION:
    - (A) AS PART OF PROVIDING PHYSICAL EDUCATION UNDER THIS SECTION, THE GOVERNING BOARD OF A PUBLIC SCHOOL SHALL ENSURE BOTH

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- 1 OF THE FOLLOWING:
- 2 (i) FOR EACH OF GRADES K TO 5, THE PUBLIC SCHOOL SHALL PROVIDE
- 3 FOR ALL PUPILS AT LEAST 30 MINUTES OF PHYSICAL EDUCATION AT LEAST 2
- 4 DAYS PER WEEK FOR THE ENTIRE SCHOOL YEAR AND SHALL ALSO PROVIDE AT
- 5 LEAST 60 ADDITIONAL MINUTES OF PHYSICAL ACTIVITY PER WEEK, WITHIN
- 6 THE SCHOOL DAY, FOR THE ENTIRE SCHOOL YEAR.
- 7 (ii) FOR EACH OF GRADES 6 TO 8, THE PUBLIC SCHOOL SHALL PROVIDE
- 8 FOR ALL PUPILS AT LEAST 45 MINUTES OF PHYSICAL EDUCATION EVERY
- 9 SCHOOL DAY FOR AT LEAST 1 SEMESTER.
- 10 (B) THE GOVERNING BOARD OF A PUBLIC SCHOOL SHALL ENSURE THAT
- 11 CLASS SIZE FOR PHYSICAL EDUCATION IS CONSISTENT WITH CLASS SIZE FOR
- 12 OTHER SUBJECT AREAS AND OTHER CLASSROOMS.
- 13 (C) THE DEPARTMENT SHALL ESTABLISH GUIDELINES FOR PHYSICAL
- 14 EDUCATION THAT ARE CONSISTENT WITH PHYSICAL EDUCATION STANDARDS,
- 15 GRADE LEVEL CONTENT EXPECTATIONS, THE STATE BOARD'S POLICY ON
- 16 QUALITY PHYSICAL EDUCATION, AND THE BEST AVAILABLE SCIENTIFIC
- 17 RESEARCH CONCERNING PHYSICAL EDUCATION. THE GOVERNING BOARD OF A

- 20 (3) (2)—A PUBLIC school district may SHALL NOT credit a
- 21 pupil's participation in extracurricular athletics or other

- 23 the physical education requirement for the pupil under subsection

- 25 (4) AS USED IN THIS SECTION, "PHYSICAL ACTIVITY" MEANS A
- 26 BEHAVIOR CONSISTING OF BODILY MOVEMENT THAT REQUIRES ENERGY
- 27 EXPENDITURE ABOVE THE NORMAL PHYSIOLOGICAL, INCLUDING MUSCULAR AND

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1 CARDIORESPIRATORY, REQUIREMENTS OF A TYPICAL SCHOOL DAY.
