## **HOUSE BILL No. 5972**

November 13, 2014, Introduced by Reps. Roberts, Geiss, Townsend, Hovey-Wright, Abed, Darany, Faris, Lane, Haugh, Cochran, Cavanagh, Dillon, Yanez, Smiley, Brunner, Phelps, Singh, Barnett, Robinson, Lipton, Switalski, Rutledge, Slavens, Kandrevas, LaVoy, Stallworth, Driskell, Segal, Schor, Kosowski and Oakes and referred to the Committee on Judiciary.

A bill to amend 1976 PA 453, entitled "Elliott-Larsen civil rights act," by amending section 601 (MCL 37.2601).

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Sec. 601. (1) The commission shall DO ALL OF THE FOLLOWING:

- (a) Maintain a principal office in the city of Lansing and other offices within the THIS state as it considers necessary.
- (b) Meet and exercise its powers at any place within the THIS state.
- (c) Appoint an executive director, who shall be IS the chief executive officer of the department and exempt from civil service, and appoint necessary hearing examiners.
- (d) Accept public grants, private gifts, bequests, or other amounts or payments.

- 1 (e) Prepare annually a comprehensive written report to the
- 2 governor. The report may contain recommendations adopted by the
- 3 commission for legislative or other action necessary to effectuate
- 4 the purposes and policies of this act.
- 5 (f) Promulgate, amend, or repeal rules to carry out this act
- 6 pursuant to Act No. 306 of the Public Acts of 1969, as amended,
- 7 being sections 24.201 to 24.315 of the Michigan Compiled Laws. THE
- 8 ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEDURES ACT OF 1969, 1969 PA 306, MCL 24.201 TO
- 9 24.328. THE COMMISSION SHALL NOT PROMULGATE RULES THAT LIMIT THE
- 10 TIME FOR FILING A SEXUAL HARASSMENT COMPLAINT WITH THE DEPARTMENT
- 11 TO LESS THAN 365 DAYS AFTER THE DATE OF THE MOST RECENT ACT OF
- 12 ALLEGED SEXUAL HARASSMENT.
- 13 (g) Request the services of a department or agency of the THIS
- 14 state or a political subdivision of the THIS state.
- 15 (h) Promote and cooperate with a public or governmental agency
- 16 as in the commission's judgment will aid in effectuating the THIS
- 17 act and the state constitution of 1963.
- 18 (i) Establish and promulgate rules governing its relationship
- 19 with local commissions, and establish criteria for certifying local
- 20 commissions for the deferring of complaints.
- 21 (2) The commission may hold hearings, administer oaths, issue
- 22 preliminary notices to witnesses to appear, compel through court
- 23 authorization the attendance of witnesses and the production for
- 24 examination of books, papers, or other records relating to matters
- 25 before the commission, take the testimony of a person under oath,
- 26 and issue appropriate orders. The commission may promulgate rules
- 27 as to the issuance of preliminary notices to appear.

- 1 (3) A majority of the members of the commission constitutes a
- 2 quorum. A majority of the members is required to take action on
- 3 matters not of a ministerial nature, but a majority of a quorum may
- 4 deal with ministerial matters. A vacancy in the commission shall
- 5 DOES not impair the right of the remaining members to exercise the
- 6 powers of the commission. The members of the commission shall
- 7 receive a per diem compensation and shall be reimbursed for the
- 8 actual and necessary expenses incurred in the performance of their
- 9 duties. The per diem compensation of the commission and the

- 19 (5) A writing prepared, owned, used, in the possession of, or
- 20 retained by the commission in the performance of an official
- 21 function shall be made available to the public in compliance with
- 22 Act No. 442 of the Public Acts of 1976, being sections 15.231 to
- 23 15.246 of the Michigan Compiled Laws. THE FREEDOM OF INFORMATION
- 24 ACT, 1976 PA 442, MCL 15.231 TO 15.246.
