## **SENATE BILL No. 944**

## May 15, 2014, Introduced by Senator HOOD and referred to the Committee on Reforms, Restructuring and Reinventing.

A bill to amend 1999 PA 212, entitled

"An act to restrict certain governmental entities from requiring individuals to reside within certain geographic areas or specified distances or travel times from their place of employment as a condition of employment or promotion,"

by amending section 2 (MCL 15.602).

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

Sec. 2. (1) Except as provided in subsection (2), THIS
 SECTION, a public employer shall not require, by collective
 bargaining agreement or otherwise, that a person reside within a
 specified geographic area or within a specified distance or travel
 time from his or her place of employment as a condition of
 employment or promotion by the public employer.
 Subsection (1) does not prohibit a public employer from

requiring, by collective bargaining agreement or otherwise, that a
 person reside within a specified distance from the nearest boundary
 of the public employer. However, the specified distance shall be 20
 miles or another specified distance greater than 20 miles.

5 (3) A requirement described in subsection (2) does not apply
6 to a person if the person is married and both of the following
7 conditions are met:

8 (a) The person's spouse is employed by another public9 employer.

10 (b) The person's spouse is subject to a condition of 11 employment or promotion that, if not for this section, would 12 require him or her to reside a distance of less than 20 miles from 13 the nearest boundary of the public employer.

14 (4) Subsection (1) does not apply if the person is a volunteer
15 or paid on-call firefighter, an elected official, or an unpaid
16 appointed official.

17 (5) SUBSECTION (1) DOES NOT APPLY TO A CITY WITH A POPULATION
18 OVER 500,000.
