HOUSE BILL No. 5049

September 28, 2017, Introduced by Rep. Kesto and referred to the Committee on Transportation and Infrastructure.

A bill to amend 1949 PA 300, entitled

"Michigan vehicle code,"

by amending section 602b (MCL 257.602b), as amended by 2016 PA 332.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

Sec. 602b. (1) Except as otherwise provided in this section, a

person shall not read, manually type, or send a text message on a wireless 2-way communication device that is located in the person's hand or in the person's lap, including a wireless telephone used in cellular telephone service or personal communication service, while operating a motor vehicle that is moving on a highway or street in this state. As used in this subsection, a wireless 2-way communication device INCLUDES A COMPUTER, TABLET DEVICE, CAMERA, OR OTHER INTERNET-BASED COMMUNICATION DEVICE BUT does not include a global positioning or navigation system that is affixed to the motor vehicle. This subsection does not apply to a person operating

- 4 ANOTHER PERSON IS GUILTY OF A FELONY PUNISHABLE BY IMPRISONMENT FOR
- 5 NOT MORE THAN 5 YEARS OR A FINE OF NOT MORE THAN \$2,000.00, OR
- 6 BOTH.
- 7 (8) A PERSON WHO VIOLATES THIS SECTION AND CAUSES SERIOUS
- 8 IMPAIRMENT OF A BODY FUNCTION TO ANOTHER PERSON IS GUILTY OF A
- 9 MISDEMEANOR PUNISHABLE BY IMPRISONMENT FOR NOT MORE THAN 1 YEAR OR
- 10 A FINE OF NOT MORE THAN \$500.00, OR BOTH.
- 11 (9) (7) This section supersedes all local ordinances
- 12 regulating the use of a communications device while operating a
- 13 motor vehicle in motion on a highway or street, except that a unit
- 14 of local government may adopt an ordinance or enforce an existing
- 15 ordinance substantially corresponding to this section.
- 16 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act takes effect 90 days
- 17 after the date it is enacted into law.
