

# HOUSE JOINT RESOLUTION MM

September 5, 2018, Introduced by Rep. Lucido and referred to the Committee on Elections and Ethics.

A joint resolution proposing an amendment to the state constitution of 1963, by adding section 9 to article XI, to require individuals to file or pay any outstanding campaign statement, report, fee, or fine before being eligible to be a candidate for state or local elective office.

Resolved by the Senate and House of Representatives of the state of Michigan, That the following amendment to the state constitution of 1963, to require individuals to file or pay any outstanding campaign statement, report, fee, or fine before being eligible to be a candidate for state or local elective office, is proposed, agreed to, and submitted to the people of the state:

ARTICLE XI

**SEC. 9. AN INDIVIDUAL IS INELIGIBLE FOR ELECTION OR REELECTION**

2 IF ANY OUTSTANDING CAMPAIGN STATEMENT, REPORT, FEE, LATE FILING  
3 FEE, OR FINE REQUIRED TO BE FILED OR PAID BY THAT INDIVIDUAL UNDER  
4 STATE LAW HAS NOT BEEN FILED OR PAID.
