

# HOUSE BILL NO. 6122

August 17, 2020, Introduced by Reps. Stone and Hernandez and referred to the Committee on Appropriations.

A bill to amend 1961 PA 236, entitled  
"Revised judicature act of 1961,"  
by amending section 151d (MCL 600.151d), as amended by 2011 PA 234.

**THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:**

1           Sec. 151d. (1) The juror compensation reimbursement fund is  
2           created in the state treasury. The money in the fund ~~shall~~**must** be  
3           used as provided in section 151e.

4           (2) The state treasurer shall credit to the juror compensation  
5           reimbursement fund deposits of proceeds from the collection of

1 driver license clearance fees as provided in section 321a(11) of  
 2 the Michigan vehicle code, 1949 PA 300, MCL 257.321a, and deposits  
 3 of proceeds from the collection of jury demand fees as provided in  
 4 sections 2529(1)(c) and 8371(9), and shall credit all income from  
 5 investment credited to the fund by the state treasurer. The state  
 6 treasurer may invest money in the fund in any manner authorized by  
 7 law for the investment of state money. However, an investment ~~shall~~  
 8 **must** not interfere with any apportionment, allocation, or payment  
 9 of money as required by section 151e. The state treasurer shall  
 10 credit to the fund all income earned as a result of an investment  
 11 of money in the fund. Except as provided in subsections (3), (4),  
 12 (5), ~~and (6)~~, **and (7)**, the unencumbered balance remaining in the  
 13 fund at the end of a fiscal year ~~shall~~**must** remain in the fund and  
 14 ~~shall~~**must** not revert to the general fund.

15 (3) For the state fiscal year ending September 30, 2005 only,  
 16 \$4,000,000.00 of the unencumbered balance remaining in the fund at  
 17 the end of that fiscal year ~~shall~~**must** be transferred by the state  
 18 treasurer to the general fund.

19 (4) For the state fiscal year ending September 30, 2008 only,  
 20 \$2,250,000.00 of the unencumbered balance remaining in the fund at  
 21 the end of that fiscal year ~~shall~~**must** be transferred by the state  
 22 treasurer to the general fund.

23 (5) For the state fiscal year ending September 30, 2010 only,  
 24 \$1,352,100.00 of the unencumbered balance remaining in the fund at  
 25 the end of that fiscal year ~~shall~~**must** be transferred by the state  
 26 treasurer to the court equity fund created in section 151b.

27 (6) For the state fiscal year ending September 30, 2011 only,  
 28 \$2,607,500.00 of the unencumbered balance remaining in the fund at  
 29 the end of that fiscal year ~~shall~~**must** be transferred by the state

1 treasurer to the court equity fund created in section 151b.

2           (7) For the state fiscal year ending September 30, 2020 only,  
3 \$2,500,000.00 of the unencumbered balance remaining in the fund at  
4 the end of that fiscal year must be transferred by the state  
5 treasurer to the general fund.
