## SUBSTITUTE FOR SENATE BILL NO. 1067

A bill to amend 1998 PA 58, entitled "Michigan liquor control code of 1998,"

by amending section 303a (MCL 436.1303a), as added by 2018 PA 155.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Sec. 303a. (1) The Michigan craft beverage council fund is 2 created within the state treasury.

3 (2) The state treasurer may receive money or other assets from any source for deposit into the Michigan craft beverage council 4 fund. The state treasurer shall direct the investment of the 5 Michigan craft beverage council fund. The state treasurer shall 6 7 credit to the Michigan craft beverage council fund interest and earnings from fund investments. 8

(3) Money in the Michigan craft beverage council fund at the

1 close of the fiscal year shall must remain in the fund and shall
2 must not lapse to the general fund. However, for the fiscal year
3 ending September 30, 2020, \$476,500.00 of the money in the Michigan
4 craft beverage council fund is transferred to and must be deposited
5 into the general fund.

6 (4) Subject to subsection (5), money from the Michigan craft
7 beverage council fund shall must be expended annually, upon on
8 appropriation, for the following:

9 (a) Not more than \$80,000.00 may be used by the department of
10 agriculture and rural development to administer the grants program
11 under section 303.

12 (b) Not less than 50% of the money that is expended after the
13 expenditure under subdivision (a) shall may be used for grants
14 under section 303(7)(a).

(c) For grants under section 303(7)(b).

16 (d) For the Michigan craft beverage council to carry out its17 responsibilities under this act.

18 (5) Notwithstanding subsection (4), if the Michigan craft
19 beverage council receives money under section 303(9)(a), the money
20 may be expended for the purposes and subject to the conditions for
21 which it was received.

22 (6) As used in this section, "Michigan craft beverage council"23 means the Michigan craft beverage council created in section 303.
