

HOUSE BILL NO. 5517

February 20, 2020, Introduced by Rep. Reilly and referred to the Committee on Health Policy.

A bill to amend 2002 PA 424, entitled
"Housing-with-services contract act,"
by amending sections 2 and 7 (MCL 333.26502 and 333.26507).

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Sec. 2. As used in this act:

2 (a) "Health-related services" means 1 or more of the
3 following:

4 (i) Nursing services.

5 (ii) Nursing services delegated to aides or personal care
6 services including, but not limited to, escort services, reminders,



1 and standby assistance related to dressing or grooming.

2 (iii) Home aide care tasks.

3 (b) "Housing-with-services establishment" means an
4 establishment regularly providing or offering to provide leased
5 private unit residences accommodating 1 or more adults, and
6 providing or offering to provide for a fee either 1 or more
7 regularly scheduled health-related services or 2 or more regularly
8 scheduled supportive services, whether offered directly by the
9 establishment or by another person by arrangement of the
10 establishment. Housing-with-services establishment does not include
11 an adult foster care facility licensed under the adult foster care
12 facility licensing act, 1979 PA 218, MCL 400.701 to 400.737, or a
13 health facility or agency licensed under article 17 of the public
14 health code, 1978 PA 368, MCL 333.20101 to ~~333.22260~~.**333.21925**.

15 (c) "Resident" means an individual leasing and residing in a
16 housing-with-services establishment.

17 (d) "Supportive services" means helping with personal laundry,
18 arranging for medical services, health-related services, social
19 services, or transportation to medical or social services
20 appointments, or providing for at least 1 individual awake and
21 alert in the housing-with-services establishment to contact a
22 service provider in an emergency. Supportive services do not
23 include making referrals or assisting a resident in contacting a
24 service provider of the resident's choice.

25 Sec. 7. Nothing in this act limits a facility's
26 responsibilities or obligations to be licensed under the adult
27 foster care facility licensing act, 1979 PA 218, MCL 400.701 to
28 400.737, or under article 17 of the public health code, 1978 PA
29 368, MCL 333.20101 to ~~333.22260~~.**333.21925**.



1 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act takes effect 90 days
2 after the date it is enacted into law.

3 Enacting section 2. This amendatory act does not take effect
4 unless Senate Bill No.____ or House Bill No.5510 (request no.
5 04667'19) of the 100th Legislature is enacted into law.
