## **HOUSE BILL NO. 5544**

February 25, 2020, Introduced by Reps. Wakeman and Marino and referred to the Committee on Regulatory Reform.

A bill to amend 1998 PA 58, entitled "Michigan liquor control code of 1998,"

(MCL 436.1101 to 436.2303) by adding section 204b.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- Sec. 204b. An on-premises licensee shall not allow on the licensed premises a machine that dispenses beer or wine directly to a customer unless all of the following conditions are met:
  - (a) The dispensing machine is located at the licensed

- 2 (b) Subject to subdivision (c), the dispensing machine does
- 3 not dispense more than 32 ounces of beer or 10 ounces of wine in a
- 4 single order.
- 5 (c) If approved by the server, the dispensing machine does not
- 6 dispense more than 48 ounces of beer or 15 ounces of wine in a
- 7 single order.
- 8 (d) The dispensing machine does not dispense spirits or mixed
- 9 spirit drink.
- 10 (e) The patron of the establishment orders the beer or wine
- 11 from a clerk, agent, or employee of the licensee.
- 12 (f) The licensee does not sell, offer to sell, or advertise
- 13 the sale of an unlimited quantity of beer or wine from the
- 14 dispensing machine.
- 15 (g) The licensee monitors the sale, service, and consumption
- 16 of beer or wine from the dispensing machine to ensure compliance
- 17 with this act and the rules promulgated under this act.
