HOUSE BILL NO. 5563

February 27, 2020, Introduced by Reps. Witwer, Camilleri, Brenda Carter, Hope, Cynthia Johnson, Kennedy, Cambensy, Love and Cherry and referred to the Committee on Regulatory Reform.

A bill to amend 1987 PA 96, entitled "The mobile home commission act,"

by amending sections 4 and 5 (MCL 125.2304 and 125.2305), section 4 as amended by 2015 PA 40 and section 5 as amended by 2006 PA 328.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 4. (1) The commission may do all of the following:
- 2 (a) After consultation with and considering comments from
- 3 representatives of the manufactured housing industry, and other

- 3 rules to the department to implement and administer this act.
- **4** (b) Act for the purpose of establishing a uniform policy

- 7 (c) Determine the sufficiency of local mobile home ordinances
- 8 that are designed to provide local governments with superintending
- 9 control over mobile home businesses, mobile home parks, or seasonal
- 10 mobile homes parks.
- 11 (d) Conduct public hearings relating to the powers prescribed
- 12 in this subsection.
- 13 (2) The director or an authorized representative of the
- 14 director shall do all of the following:
- 15 (a) After consultation with and considering comments from
- 16 representatives of the manufactured housing industry, and other
- 17 interested parties, residents of mobile home parks, and members of
- 18 the commission who are residents of mobile home parks, promulgate
- 19 rules to implement and administer this act.
- 20 (b) On or before June 1, 2020, and every year after that date,
- 21 provide a report to the commission regarding health and safety
- 22 complaints received by the department as described under

- (c) (b) Conduct hearings relating to violations of this act or

- 26 (d) (c) Make investigations to determine compliance with this

- (e) (d) Provide assistance to the commission as the commission
- 29 requires.



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- (f) (e) On not less than a quarterly basis, report to the 1 commission on the expenditure of all fees collected under this act 2 3 and the relation of those expenditures to the enforcement and administration of this act.
- 5 (a) (f) Post and maintain on the department's website all 6 current quidelines.
 - (h) (g) Promptly notify a local government of the issuance, amendment, or rescission of a guideline if the department has knowledge that a mobile home park or seasonal mobile home park is located in, or an application has been filed for the licensure of a park proposed to be located in, the local government. The notice shall must be sent by first-class mail or electronic mail to each of the following:
 - (i) The clerk of the local government.
 - (ii) The chief executive officer of the local government.
- 16 (iii) The enforcing agency for the local government if, under 17 section 8a or 8b of the Stille-DeRossett-Hale single state 18 construction code act, 1972 PA 230, MCL 125.1508a and 125.1508b, 19 the local government has assumed responsibility for the 20 administration and enforcement within its jurisdiction of that act and the state construction code or a part of the state construction 21 22 code of limited application.
 - (i) (h)—If the department receives a complaint about a condition at a mobile home park or seasonal mobile home park that imminently threatens the health or safety of the residents of the park, promptly notify each local government in which the park is located of the details of the complaint.
- 28 (3) The commission shall not regulate mobile homes that are 29 not located within a mobile home park or a seasonal mobile home

- 8 the department shall promulgate the mobile home code subject to
- 9 section 4. The code shall consist of rules governing all of the
- 10 following:
- 11 (a) The licensure, density, layout, permits for construction,
- 12 construction of mobile home parks including standards for roads,
- 13 utilities, open space, or proposed recreational facilities, and
- 14 safety measures sufficient to protect health, safety, and welfare
- 15 of mobile home park residents, except water supply, sewage
- 16 collection and treatment, and drainage facilities which that are
- 17 regulated by the department of environmental quality.
- 18 (b) The business, sales, and service practices of mobile home
- 19 dealers.
- 20 (c) The business practices of mobile home installers and
- 21 repairers.
- 22 (d) The licensure and regulations of mobile home installers
- 23 and repairers.
- 24 (e) The setup and installation of mobile homes inside mobile
- 25 home parks or seasonal mobile home parks.
- 26 (f) The regulation of the responsibilities, under the mobile
- 27 home warranty, of the mobile home components manufacturer, the
- 28 mobile home assembler or manufacturer, and the mobile home dealer,
- 29 including the time period and relationships of each under the



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- warranty, and the remedies available, if any, if the responsibleparties cease to operate as a business.
 - (g) Abuses relating to all of the following:
- 4 (i) Consumer deposits, except utility deposits from consumers
 5 who are direct customers of utilities regulated by the Michigan
 6 public service commission.
- 7 (ii) Detailed listing of furnishings and fixtures by a
 8 manufacturer of a new mobile home or a mobile home dealer for a
 9 used mobile home.
 - (iii) Disclosure and delivery of manufacturer's warranties.
- 11 (iv) Used mobile homes. A mobile home dealer shall provide
 12 detailed listing of its service records for used mobile homes which
 13 that are being sold by the dealer and of which the dealer has
 14 knowledge.
- (h) Applications for and issuance of certificates of title for mobile homes.
- (2) As part of the code, the department shall also promulgate 17 rules governing the licensure, density, layout, permits for 18 construction, and construction of seasonal mobile home parks, 19 20 including standards for roads, utilities, open space, proposed 21 recreational facilities, and safety measures sufficient to protect 22 the health, safety, and welfare of seasonal mobile home park 23 residents, except water supply, sewage collection and treatment, 24 and drainage facilities, which shall be regulated by the department 25 of environmental quality.
- (3) The rules promulgated for seasonal mobile home parks may
 impose a less stringent standard than the rules promulgated for
 mobile home parks.

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
