A bill to amend 1967 PA 281, entitled "Income tax act of 1967,"

(MCL 206.1 to 206.713) by adding section 280.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

Sec. 280. (1) For the 2020 tax year only, a taxpayer who is a qualified first responder or a qualified health care professional may claim a credit against the tax imposed by this part in an amount equal to his or her income tax liability under this part attributable to income earned on and after March 1, 2020 through
