Sec. 10a. All of the following apply in the conduct of a

 shall conduct a millionaire party as follows:

(b) A-The millionaire party licensee shall not permit a wager

taking place at the location and during the time period approved
for the event, and in no event shall or a wager to be placed upon
on an athletic event or upon on a game involving personal skill.
