- 8 health centers and programs in the state of Michigan that provide a
- 9 range of primary, preventive, early intervention, and mental health
- 10 services to children and youth of all grade levels in urban, rural,

- 2 Whereas, Children and youth served by school-based and school-
- 3 linked health centers show improved rates of school attendance,
- 4 enhanced scores on standardized tests, less absenteeism due to
- 5 illness, and increased immunization rates, while also having their
- 6 wellness and healthcare needs addressed; and
- 7 Whereas, School-Based Health Care Awareness Month is a time to
- 8 acknowledge the commitment and passion that school-based and
- 9 school-linked health center staff and parent/quardians show for all
- 10 Michigan children and youth; and
- 11 Whereas, We also recognize the critical role these individuals
- 12 play in improving the health and well-being of all Michigan
- 13 children; now, therefore, be it
