SUMMARY:

House Bill 6212 would amend the Fire Prevention Code to provide that, within 24 hours after a circuit court makes an order to abate, remove, correct, or discontinue a fire hazard in response to an action brought by the state fire marshal, the state fire marshal must notify in writing the members of the Senate and House of Representatives who represent the area where the fire hazard is located.

MCL 29.23

FISCAL IMPACT:

House Bill 6212 would have a negligible fiscal impact on the Department of Licensing and Regulatory Affairs (LARA), given the limited number of notices that the department would need to submit. The bill would not have a fiscal impact on any other units of state or local government.
