THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 4v. (1) Each city may in its charter authorize the use of 2 ranked choice voting for the election of city officers.
- 3 (2) If a city charter authorizes the use of ranked choice 4 voting, the city charter must provide for all of the following:
- 5 (a) That ranked choice voting may only be used for the 6 election of city officers.
 - (b) That ranked choice voting may only be used when the

- 1 election of city officers is the only election on the ballot.
