A bill to amend 2011 PA 152, entitled "Publicly funded health insurance contribution act," by amending section 8 (MCL 15.568), as amended by 2014 PA 184.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 8. (1) By a 2/3 vote of its governing body each year,
- 2 prior to the beginning of the medical benefit plan coverage year, a
- 3 local unit of government may exempt itself from the requirements of
- 4 this act for the next succeeding medical benefit plan coverage

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- 1 year.
- 2 (2) A 2/3 vote of the governing body of the local unit of
- 3 government prior to the beginning of each succeeding medical
- 4 benefit plan coverage year is required to extend an exemption under
- 5 this section.
- 6 (3) An exemption under this section is not effective for a
- 7 city with a mayor who is both the chief executive and chief
- 8 administrator, unless the mayor also approves the exemption.
- 9 (4) An exemption under this section is not effective for a
- 10 county with a county executive who is both the chief executive and
- 11 chief administrator, unless the county executive also approves the
- 12 exemption.
- 13 (5) An exemption under this section is not effective for a
- 14 city with a population greater than 600,000.
- 15 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act takes effect 90 days
- 16 after the date it is enacted into law.
