

SENATE BILL NO. 1039

May 17, 2022, Introduced by Senator SANTANA and referred to the Committee on Appropriations.

A bill to amend 2011 PA 152, entitled
"Publicly funded health insurance contribution act,"
by amending section 8 (MCL 15.568), as amended by 2014 PA 184.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Sec. 8. (1) By a 2/3 vote of its governing body each year,
2 prior to the beginning of the medical benefit plan coverage year, a
3 local unit of government may exempt itself from the requirements of
4 this act for the next succeeding medical benefit plan coverage

1 year.

2 (2) A 2/3 vote of the governing body of the local unit of
3 government prior to the beginning of each succeeding medical
4 benefit plan coverage year is required to extend an exemption under
5 this section.

6 (3) An exemption under this section is not effective for a
7 city with a mayor who is both the chief executive and chief
8 administrator, unless the mayor also approves the exemption.

9 (4) An exemption under this section is not effective for a
10 county with a county executive who is both the chief executive and
11 chief administrator, unless the county executive also approves the
12 exemption.

13 ~~(5) An exemption under this section is not effective for a~~
14 ~~city with a population greater than 600,000.~~

15 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act takes effect 90 days
16 after the date it is enacted into law.
