

## HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 19

Rep. Witwer offered the following concurrent resolution:

1       A concurrent resolution to waive the legislative notice  
2 requirement for increases in rates of compensation for certain  
3 employees in the state classified service.

4       Whereas, Article XI, Section 5 of the *Constitution of the*  
5 *State of Michigan of 1963* provides, in relevant part:

6       Increases in rates of compensation authorized by the commission  
7 may be effective only at the start of a fiscal year and shall  
8 require prior notice to the governor, who shall transmit such  
9 increases to the legislature as part of his budget. The  
10 legislature may, by a majority vote of the members elected to  
11 and serving in each house, waive the notice and permit increases  
12 in rates of compensation to be effective at a time other than  
13 the start of a fiscal year;

1           Whereas, New compensation plans for various exclusively  
2 represented positions in certain classifications have been settled  
3 upon as a result of the negotiations recently completed between the  
4 AFSCME Council 25, Michigan State Employees Association, the UAW  
5 International and its Local 6000, the Service Employees  
6 International Union Local 517 Scientific and Engineering Unit, and  
7 the Service Employees International Union Local 517M Technical  
8 Unit. This settlement was reached past the time when the Governor  
9 could transmit the increase as part of the budget; and

10           Whereas, The State Personnel Director, with the consent of the  
11 chair of the Civil Service Commission, granted approval of the  
12 newly negotiated pay schedules on June 25, 2022; now, therefore, be  
13 it

14           Resolved by the House of Representatives (the Senate  
15 concurring), That, pursuant to Article XI, Section 5 of the  
16 *Constitution of the State of Michigan of 1963*, we waive the prior  
17 notice requirement to permit increases in rates of compensation for  
18 certain employees in the state classified service as set in the  
19 agreement reached between the AFSCME Council 25, Michigan State  
20 Employees Association, the UAW International and its Local 6000,  
21 the Service Employees International Union Local 517 Scientific and  
22 Engineering Unit, and the Service Employees International Union  
23 Local 517M Technical Unit; and be it further

24           Resolved, That copies of this resolution be transmitted to the  
25 members of the Civil Service Commission.
