- 1 A resolution to declare June 23-28, 2021, as Pollinator Week
- 2 in the state of Michigan.
- 3 Whereas, Pollinators are an essential part of Michigan's
- 4 economy and key to sustaining agriculture, biodiversity, and
- 5 environmental sustainability in the long and short-term future; and
- 6 Whereas, The United States Senate has been commemorating
- 7 National Pollinator Week for over 14 years to bring focus on the
- 8 declining population of essential pollinators and it is time for
- 9 Michigan to follow suit with action; and
- 10 Whereas, Michigan pollinators such as bees, butterflies,

beetles, and bats all make up an essential element to our state's 1 2 well-being. With pollinators in decline, nearly 1/3 of all food eaten is at stake and 75% of all flowering plants are at risk; and 3 4 Whereas, The Pollinator Partnership and numerous legislators are committed to educating the public about this growing issue and 5 6 the importance these species play in the economy while introducing bipartisan legislation to alleviate a potential pollinator crisis; 7 8 and 9 Whereas, This effort to educate and act is intended to secure 10 the future of Michigan's pollinator populations and Michigan's 11 vibrant agricultural economy with a continuing gaze towards 12 sustaining this land's natural beauty; now, therefore, be it 13 Resolved by the House of Representatives, That members of this 14 legislative body declare June 23-28, 2021, as Pollinator Week in
